One hears a great deal about the **property rights** of homeowners these days, and I agree we should have them honored and protected. However, my own take and that of many of my neighbors is the right that **we have** to protect the value of our homes, many of them historic, by having in place some sort of oversight over the potential destruction of a perfectly fine existing residence or the construction of a new oversized home which may be out of scale and/or of an inappropriate style for the neighborhood.

My wife and I purchased a Village home from the 1880's some 24 years ago, and we feel it is important for the Town of Zionsville to safeguard our investment of purchase price and ongoing maintenance. We thank you for voting in favor of the establishment of a Conservation Commission at the April 11th Council meeting and hope you will do so again on May 2nd. We feel the eventual establishment of a Conservation District is critical to protect the look and feel of the Village, and hence our property values.
