We are only 2 days away from the Town Council voting on the creation of a Historic Preservation Commission.

Changes have been made by the Town to the proposed [ordinance](#) to create a Commission:

- Language has been added to help ensure that a Conservation District **cannot** automatically turn into a Historic District
- Paint colors are no longer allowed to be reviewed in a Conservation District
