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### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2017

#### 1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Twenty-one (21) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Fifteen (15) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Worked with the Parks Naturalist and representatives of Eagle Elementary to relocate the Town Hall rain garden to the school as the garden was to be demolished as a component of the new Town Hall project. Street & Stormwater staff removed all plant and stone material from Town Hall, transported it to the school and excavated the new garden. Volunteers then installed the landscape stone and plants.
- d) Coordinated with the White River Alliance to have a corporate “Stormwater Action Team” clean storm drains and install “no dumping” placards on all drains in the Raintree Place subdivision.
- e) Assistant Superintendent – Stormwater was presented with the Excellence in Stormwater Management Award at the annual statewide Indiana Association of Stormwater and Floodplain Managers (INAFSM) conference.

#### 2. **96<sup>TH</sup> ST./ZIONSVILLE RD. INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

Construction is substantially complete and a pre-final walk-through is scheduled for the first week of October.

#### 3. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

Design efforts will continue over the next several months. Land acquisition activities have begun and are hoped to be complete by the end of the year, along with final design. Consideration is currently being given to closing the road to through-traffic during construction to save both time and money on the project. All local access would be maintained.

4. **COMMUNITY CROSSINGS GRANT AWARD PROJECTS**

The Town was awarded \$486,562.71 from INDOT as part of the Community Crossings grant program. Roads to be repaired include:

- Repair and resurface CR 950 East from approximately the north edge of the Courtyards subdivision to Whitestown Road as a joint project with the Boone County Highway Department
- Repair and resurface Oak Street from Quail Run Drive to CR 950 East/Sheets Road
- Reconstruction of Parkway Drive in its entirety
- Reconstruction of Brendon Way in its entirety
- Repair and resurface Maxwell Lane

Construction is expected to begin in late spring of 2018.

5. **CR 700 PATHWAY**

Construction has begun on this project and is expected to be completed by the end of November, weather permitting.

6. **4<sup>TH</sup> ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II**

As previously reported, all bids received at the July 14<sup>th</sup> bid opening were in excess of the engineer's estimate as well as the project budget. Accordingly, at the recommendation of the project's design engineer, the bids have been officially rejected for exceeding the engineer's estimate and project budget, anomalies in bid pricing and the inability to obtain the final easement necessary to construct the project. The Town Engineer is completing an appraisal of the subject property and necessary easement to position the Town to make a formal, justified offer. The project will be considered for re-bidding if and when the easement has been obtained.

7. **3<sup>RD</sup> ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Design work is complete and an advertisement for bids will be published in early October with a bid opening scheduled for 3:00 pm on October 20<sup>th</sup>. The project is designed to increase storm sewer capacity and to reduce flooding along portions of N. 3rd St. between Oak St. and Walnut St. Pending approval of the 2018 budget, phases I and II may be combined to complete the corridor improvements under one contract. Construction is expected to begin in 2017 and carried over into early 2018.

8. **FORD RD. & MULBERRY ST. NEW ROUNDABOUT**

This project is complete.

9. **2017 STREET REPAIR AND REHAB PROGRAM**

Work is substantially complete on this project, and the contractor is completing punch-list items prior to final completion.

10. **VILLAGE WALK DR. RECONSTRUCTION**

Work is substantially complete on this project, and the contractor is completing punch-list items prior to final completion.

11. **STAFFING CHANGES**

A new Assistant Superintendent – Streets, Shane Rance has joined the department to replace Wes Simpson who resigned to take a position in the private sector.

12. **FALL LEAF COLLECTION**

Curbside leaf collection for residents in the urban service district will begin the week of October 23<sup>rd</sup> and run through December 1<sup>st</sup>. An additional week of service will be considered based on weather and other conditions.

13. **FALL BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION**

The fall round of brush and limb collection for residents in the urban service district begins Monday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Information has been posted to the Town's web site.



## Fall 2017 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street & Stormwater Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning Monday, October 2, 2017**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the Urban district a means to dispose of certain pruning and yard debris. We cannot guarantee the collection unless your items are out curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your designated pick-up day.

The limit on size is 6 inches in diameter and smaller. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will NOT be collected. Bundling is not required. Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
