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STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2017

1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Six (6) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Fourteen (14) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Working with the White River Alliance and several area municipalities to hold a workshop for HOA's, landscape contractors and pond management companies on how to properly maintain stormwater best management practices (BMPs) such as ponds, water quality treatment units, rain gardens and porous pavements. The workshop will be held at the Noblesville City Hall on December 7th.
- d) Completed stormwater facility assessments at the Golf Course and Municipal Services Building. All facilities were found to be properly implementing their Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans.

2. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

Design is nearing completion. Land acquisition activities are ongoing and 13 of approximately 25 parcels have been secured. Eight parcels have been or are in the process of being filed for condemnation as a result of failed negotiations. Consideration is currently being given to closing the road to through-traffic during construction to save both time and money on the project while maintaining local access.

3. **COMMUNITY CROSSINGS GRANT AWARD PROJECTS**

The Town was awarded \$486,562.71 from INDOT as part of the Community Crossings grant program. A bid opening will be held on December 14th for this project, which includes:

- Repair and resurface Oak Street from Quail Run Drive to CR 950 East/Sheets Road
- Reconstruction of Parkway Drive in its entirety
- Reconstruction of Brendon Way in its entirety

- Repair and resurface Maxwell Lane

4. **CR 700 PATHWAY**

Construction is ongoing but has been halted by weather. The goal was to be complete by the end of November, but weather and site conditions have likely resulted in a delay of the paving until spring.

5. **BENNETT PARKWAY EXTENSION PHASE II**

An application seeking federal dollars to fund a portion of the extension of Bennett Parkway south to 96th St. has been submitted to the Indianapolis MPO for consideration. As presented, the request would provide approximately \$8.7M in federal funds in fiscal year 2023 to be matched by approximately \$3.6M in local funding. Results of the application will be announced in the first half of 2018.

6. **4TH ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II**

All necessary easements and rights of entry have been obtained and the project has been advertised for re-bidding with an opening scheduled for December 14th.

7. **3RD ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

A Notice to Proceed has been issued to Calumet Civil Contractors, Inc. Construction is expected to begin in late December or early January pending weather, and be completed in spring 2018.

8. **IRONGATE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Preliminary engineering was completed in 2015 to identify mitigation options to address historical drainage problems in the subdivision and along W. Oak Street. The project engineer has been re-engaged to complete design work and produce final construction plans to be considered for future funding.

9. **9TH ST. TO 6TH ST. DRAINAGE STUDY**

Preliminary engineering work is being completed to evaluate capacity needs and mitigation options to address historical drainage problems through this corridor, located north of Oak St. in the Village.

10. **NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTOR**

Design has begun on a new roadway segment that will connect the intersection of 850 E./Cooper Rd. with CR 875 E. to the north. The design includes a roundabout at the intersection of 850 E./Cooper Rd. and Oak St. as well as a roundabout at the intersection of CR 875 E. and Whitestown Rd. Construction is anticipated to begin in 2019. This project is fulfilling the future visions of Zionsville's Transportation Plan.

11. **CR 875 E./WHITESTOWN RD. INTERSECTION MODIFICATIONS**

To eliminate confusion and improve performance, the oddly-configured intersection of CR 875 E. and Whitestown Rd. will be modified by removing the "slip lane" at the southeast corner. This will make the intersection a standard 4-way stop until such time in the future when a roundabout is constructed.

12. **FALL LEAF COLLECTION**

Curbside leaf collection for residents in the urban service district concludes the first week of December. All residents are to have leaf piles street-side by the morning of December 4th to guaranteed collection.
