STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2018

1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**
 - a) Thirteen (13) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
 - b) Sixteen (16) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
 - c) Worked with the White River Alliance and several area municipalities to hold the annual Trained Individual Contractor Training and Certification program. This program was developed to provide convenient and economical training to help contractors maintain compliance with state and local construction stormwater pollution prevention requirements. 190 contractors attended.

2. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

This project is out for bid with an opening scheduled for April 19th. Pending favorable bids, construction is expected to begin in June.

3. **4TH ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II**

Due to errors by AT&T to properly locate their underground facilities several months ago, this project had to be halted and re-designed to avoid the conflict. Construction has since resumed and the project is still on schedule and pending weather, expected to be completed in spring of 2018. The additional cost and time delay to the town is being quantified.

4. **3RD ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

The project is on schedule, and pending weather, expected to be completed in spring of 2018.

5. **NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTOR**

Design continues on a new roadway segment that will connect the intersection of 850 E./Cooper Rd. with CR 875 E. to the north. The design includes a roundabout at the intersection of 850 E./Cooper Rd. and Oak St. as well as a roundabout at the intersection of CR 875 E. and Whitestown Rd. Construction is

anticipated to begin in 2019. This project is fulfilling the future visions of Zionsville's Transportation Plan.

6. NEW MUNICIPAL FACILITY

Preliminary design development has begun on a new facility to be located at the former Rail-Trail Gardens along CR 875 E. just north of the ZCH Sports Complex. This site, encompassing approximately 24 acres has been purchased by the town to house both Parks & Rec facilities as well as Street & Stormwater Dept. operations. Preliminary layouts and cost estimates are expected mid-summer.

7. MAIN ST. BRIDGE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS

Engineering work has begun on a project to improve pedestrian mobility along South Main St., specifically on Bridge 202 crossing Eagle Creek south of the downtown business district. The bridge and approaches will be modified to eliminate the center turn lane, narrow the remaining two lanes and provide a protected, separated 10' multi-use pathway along each side of the road. This alternative to a stand-alone pedestrian bridge will provide pedestrian access on each side of Main St. and is anticipated to be substantially less expensive than a separate pedestrian bridge along only the west side of the road. This project is expected to be completed by the end of 2018.

8. COMMUNITY CROSSINGS MATCHING GRANT STREET REPAIR PROJECT

The following projects are expected to begin construction activities in April and be completed within 120 days:

- Repair and resurface Oak Street from Quail Run Drive to CR 950 East/Sheets Road
- Reconstruction of Parkway Drive in its entirety
- Reconstruction of Brendon Way in its entirety
- Repair and resurface Maxwell Lane
- Installation of new pedestrian crossings, signals, and sidewalks at the intersection of Oak St. and Ford Rd.

9. CR 700 PATHWAY PROJECT

Weather permitting, construction of this pathway is expected to resume in April. Dry conditions and temperatures above 45° are necessary to complete this project.

10. HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION

The annual collection of heavy trash in the urban service district has been set for the week of May 7th. This is an opportunity for residents in the urban service district to dispose of non-hazardous household items that are not normally collected with their weekly trash service. Collection will again be on residents' regular trash day during this week, and information and details have been coordinated with the Director of Communications and Community Relations for dissemination. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department directly for this information as well. As with previous years, there will be no charge to residents to dispose of tires or refrigerant-bearing appliances; however, residents wishing to dispose of these items are requested to notify the Street and

Stormwater Department as the collection process differs from standard heavy-trash items.

11. BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION

The spring round of brush and limb collection for Zionsville residents in the urban district has been scheduled for the weeks of April 17th and April 24th. The specific schedule has been posted to the Town's web site and coordinated with the Director of Communications and Community Relations for dissemination. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department for their specific day of collection, and the schedule is attached to this report.

Spring 2018 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street & Stormwater Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning Monday, April 16, 2018**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the Urban Service district a means to dispose of certain pruning and yard debris. We cannot guarantee the collection unless your items are out curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your designated pick-up day.

The limit on size is 6 inches in diameter and smaller. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will **NOT** be collected. Bundling is not required. Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
