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STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 2018

1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Twenty (20) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Nineteen (19) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Two (2) Stormwater Management Permits were issued for new development projects.
- d) Issued two (2) Notices of Violation and Fines for construction stormwater pollution prevention violations at permitted development projects.
- e) Conducted Stormwater Facility Assessments at Fire Station 91 and the Wastewater Treatment Plant. These assessments ensure that municipal facilities are properly implementing their Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans in accordance with the Town's NPDES permit requirements.
- f) The Creekfest Planning Committee is working to coordinate this year's event on Saturday, August 18th. The event will be held from 10 am to 1 pm and features a stream cleanup and a variety of other activities.

2. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

A preconstruction meeting with the contractor, utilities, engineers and Town officials is scheduled for June 1st. At that time, a tentative project schedule will be provided by the contractor for review. Several utilities must relocate their facilities prior to the start of major road construction, and two parcels from which new right of way is required are still being finalized. It is expected that a Notice to Proceed will be issued in the next two to three weeks, with preliminary construction activities will begin near the end of June. Road closures are anticipated to occur in July and remain in effect throughout the rest of 2018. Further important project details will be posted to various media outlets as soon as they are finalized and available.

3. **4TH ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II**

This project has reached final completion with minor punch list items remaining.

4. **3RD ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

This project has reached final completion with minor punch list items remaining.

5. **NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTOR**

Design continues on a new roadway segment that will connect the intersection of 850 E./Cooper Rd. with CR 875 E. to the north. The design includes a roundabout at the intersection of 850 E./Cooper Rd. and Oak St. as well as a roundabout at the intersection of CR 875 E. and Whitestown Rd. Construction is anticipated to begin in 2019. This project is fulfilling the future visions of Zionsville's Transportation Plan.

6. **NEW MUNICIPAL FACILITY**

Preliminary site design development is on-going for a new facility to be located at the former Rail-Trail Gardens along CR 875 E. just north of the ZCH Sports Complex. This site, encompassing approximately 24 acres has been purchased by the Town to house both Parks & Rec facilities as well as Street & Stormwater Dept. operations. Preliminary layouts and cost estimates are expected mid-summer.

7. **MAIN ST. BRIDGE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS**

This project to modify Boone County bridge #219 on South Main St. over Eagle Creek in order to provide 10' multi-use pathways on each side of the road is currently out for public bid. A bid opening has been scheduled for June 21st at 3:00 pm in room 103 of the Zionsville Town Hall.

8. **COMMUNITY CROSSINGS MATCHING GRANT STREET REPAIR PROJECT**

Construction activities are ongoing on the following projects and are expected to be completed within 90 days:

- Repair and resurface Oak Street from Quail Run Drive to CR 950 East/Sheets Road
- Reconstruction of Parkway Drive in its entirety
- Reconstruction of Brendon Way in its entirety
- Repair and resurface Maxwell Lane
- Installation of new pedestrian crossings, signals, and sidewalks at the intersection of Oak St. and Ford Rd.

9. **CR 700 PATHWAY PROJECT**

The contractor has submitted a date of May 30 to return to this project, but weather delayed that restart. Construction is anticipated to resume by mid-June and be substantially complete by the end of June.

10. **2018 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**

Preliminary engineering is nearly complete on several roads to be repaired, resurfaced or reconstructed as part of the 2018 Road Rehab Program. Streets currently being considered include:

- Pine St. from 8th St. to 9th St.
- 2nd St. from Oak St. to Poplar St.
- 9th St. from Pine St. to Oak St.
- Sycamore St. from 8th St. to 6th St.
- 6th St. from Sycamore St. to Oak St.
- 3rd St. from Oak St. to Ash St.

- Cedar St. from 3rd St. to 1st St.
- Irongate Circle
- Walden Ct.
- Rockwell Ct.
- Sherwood Ct.
- Holiday Ct.
- Trenton Ct.
- Lynn Ct.
- Redding Ct.
- Garden Pt.
- N. Maxwell Ln.
- Princeton Pl.
- Orchard Pt.
- Cedar Mill Ct.
- Scranton Ct.
- York Cr.
- Woodstock Ct.
- Leeds Ct.
- Park Pl.
- Blackstone Pl.
- Crown Pt.
- Bennington Dr.

Certain streets may be deleted based on final estimates and/or pricing received from contractors. This project is expected to be advertised for public bid on June 13th with an anticipated bid opening date of June 29th.

11. ANNUAL INDOT ROAD INVENTORY CERTIFICATION

INDOT has certified the road mileage inventory submitted in 2017 bringing the acknowledged centerline road mileage for the town from 99.9 mi. to 104.4 mi.

12. ANNUAL OPERATIONAL REPORT FOR LOCAL ROADS AND STREETS

Due to the Town's certified population now exceeding 20,000 residents, staff is required to annually file an operational report with INDOT and the State Board of Accounts detailing expenditures in all funds utilized for road maintenance. The initial report has been filed in a timely manner in accordance with state requirements, posted to the Town's web site and will be a requirement each subsequent year.

12. DIGITAL RADAR SPEED LIMIT SIGN INSTALLATION

Six (6) new digital radar-feedback signs have been purchased by the Zionsville Police Department and have been installed in the vicinity of three (3) Zionsville schools: Union Elementary, Zionsville Middle School and Zionsville High School. These signs are expected to be activated by ZPD in June.
