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STREET DEPARTMENT REPORT ZIONSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING JULY 6, 2009

1. 106TH ST. REALIGNMENT AND RECONSTRUCTION

The intersection of 106th St. and Bennett Parkway has reopened, and traffic has been switched to a portion of the new alignment as construction moves into Phase II. Paving of the south half of 106th St. through Andrade Industrial Park is scheduled to begin this coming Thursday, and be complete by Saturday at the latest. Access is being maintained to all businesses, and the contractor has been very pro-active in communicating various nuances of drive reconstructions to the affected businesses.

2. STARKEY PATHWAY

The final grading and seeding is complete. The contractor has yet to install guardrail sections, which are currently being fabricated and should be installed within the next two weeks.

3. DOWNTOWN STREETScape PROJECT

This project began June 15th, and the contractor is scheduled to begin storm sewer installation this week, followed by sidewalk and curb installation. The project will be phased essentially from the south to the north, and daily traffic restrictions and closures are being kept to a minimum. Some unforeseen utility conflicts have arisen, and Miller Pipeline is diligently working to relocate gas mainlines owned and operated by Vectren Energy. Vectren has opted to replace dated gas mainlines not associated with the relocations necessary for the project, and it is not expected that the utility work will delay the project.

4. SR 334 AND TURKEYFOOT PATHWAY DESIGNS

A public meeting to discuss these two projects will be scheduled for later this month and published in the Zionsville Times Sentinel and on the Town's web site.

5. ANNUAL STREET REPAIR PROGRAM

A bid opening is scheduled for tomorrow, July 7th at 3:00 pm for this year's annual street repair program.

6. SHELL SITE PARKING LOT

Design is approximately 75% complete for the new parking lot. This project is now referred to as the Downtown Main Street Parking Lot Project. The plans currently provide an additional 35 parking spaces, location for a bike rack and reservation of space for a Christmas tree. Landscaping and planting areas are also being provided.
