### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2018

#### 1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Sixteen (16) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Fifteen (15) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential and commercial construction projects.
- c) Two (2) Stormwater Management Permits were issued for new development projects.
- d) Renewed the Town's NPDES stormwater permit by submitting a Notice of Intent and updated Stormwater Quality Management Plan to the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM).
- e) Held the annual Creekfest event at Elm Street Green with record attendance of 321 total participants! Creekfest is a collaborative effort involving the Street & Stormwater and Parks Departments, Boone County Solid Waste Management District and Zionsville residents and businesses. The stream cleanup was cancelled due to heavy rains and resulting unsafe conditions in Eagle Creek.
- f) Assistant Superintendent – Stormwater was invited by IDEM to participate as a representative of central Indiana MS4s on an advisory committee that is helping guide efforts to transition the existing rule-based stormwater NPDES permit requirements to a general permit, in accordance with an EPA directive.
- g) Hosted the Boone County Solid Waste Management District's annual Household Hazardous Waste Disposal and Electronics Recycling event at the Municipal Services Building. A record 537 vehicles visited the event.

2. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**  
Clearing of trees and vegetation along the project is expected to be completed by September 6<sup>th</sup>, at which time the road will reopen to through-traffic. The multiple utilities who must relocate their facilities are expected to be working along this corridor through the end of 2018. Five parcels from whom additional right of way was acquired through condemnation have been successfully mediated, eliminating the potential for a trial to determine property value. One parcel remains to be finalized, and attempts are on-going to incorporate minor additions to the project to mitigate property owners' concerns and avoid a trial.
3. **4<sup>TH</sup> ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II**  
The project is complete.
4. **3<sup>RD</sup> ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**  
The project has reached final completion with minor punch list items remaining.
5. **NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTOR**  
A public meeting to present the current design and potential impacts to the public has been scheduled for September 18<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 pm in the Community Room at the Town Hall. Information will be provided to the media as well as posted to the town's web site and social media.
6. **NEW MUNICIPAL FACILITY**  
Preliminary site design development is nearing completion for the new facility to be located at the former Rail-Trail Gardens along CR 875 E. just north of the ZCH Sports Complex.
7. **MAIN ST. BRIDGE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS**  
Work is on-going for this project and is expected to be completed by the end of November.
8. **COMMUNITY CROSSINGS MATCHING GRANT STREET REPAIR PROJECT**  
Construction activities are mostly completed on this project, with only the installation of new pedestrian crossings, signals, and sidewalks at the intersection of Oak St. and Ford Rd. and the repair and resurfacing of Oak Street from Quail Run Drive to CR 950 East/Sheets Road remaining.
9. **CR 700 PATHWAY PROJECT**  
This project is complete.
10. **2018 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**  
Construction activities are expected to commence by September 11<sup>th</sup> on the following streets and be completed by November:
  - Pine St. from 8<sup>th</sup> St. to 9<sup>th</sup> St.
  - 9<sup>th</sup> St. from Pine St. to Oak St.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> St. from Oak St. to Poplar. St.
  - Sycamore St. from 8<sup>th</sup> St. to 6<sup>th</sup> St.

- 6<sup>th</sup> St. from Sycamore to Oak St.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> St. from Oak St. to Ash St.
- Cedar St. from 3<sup>rd</sup> St. to 1<sup>st</sup> St.

This project also includes two (2) bid alternates: #1) the repair and resurfacing of the public parking lot on Hawthorne St., and #2) the repair and resurfacing of the Municipal Building parking lot.

**11. CR 300 PLANNING GRANT**

Through a joint application with the Boone County Highway Department, the Indianapolis MPO has awarded \$82,500 out of a total of \$150,000 to fund a planning study of CR 300 to determine future demands, needs and capacities. The local contribution of \$67,500 will be split between Boone County and Zionsville. The selection of a consultant will occur in the near future, and the process is expected to include public input meetings.

**12. 2018 FALL LEAF COLLECTION**

Curbside leaf collection for residents in the urban service district will begin the week of October 22<sup>nd</sup> and run through December 7<sup>th</sup>, pending winter weather. Additional days may be added depending on the need and favorable weather.

**13. 2018 FALL BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION**

The fall round of brush and limb collection for residents in the urban service district begins Monday, October 1<sup>st</sup>.

## Fall 2018 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street & Stormwater Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning Monday, October 1, 2018**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the Urban Service District a means to dispose of certain pruning and yard debris. We cannot guarantee the collection unless your items are out curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your designated pick-up day.

The limit on size is 6 inches in diameter and smaller. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will **NOT** be collected. Bundling is not required. Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
