Zionsville expands emergency preparedness network

WHAT:

The Zionsville Fire Department is pleased to announce that two additional emergency warning sirens have been installed in the Zionsville service area in addition to the three new sirens that were installed in 2018.

WHERE:

The new sirens are located at 9275 E. SR 32 and 5361 S. US 421.

WHY:

These five new sirens help with on-going community risk reduction efforts by expanding the emergency notification system for the greater Zionsville area.

WHEN:

Those who would like to learn more about types of weather emergencies that trigger siren activation can attend a National Weather Service Storm Spotter class on Feb. 27, 2019 from 1 – 4 p.m. at Zionsville Town Hall.
