



## ZIONSVILLE STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT

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### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 2019

1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Fourteen (11) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Two (8) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) One (1) Stormwater Management Permits were issued for a demo project.
- d) Cleaned Municipal Service Building inlet protection. Removed approximately 200 pounds of wet material.

2. **IRONGATE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Design work is complete on this project to help mitigate historical drainage issues along W. Oak Street and Irongate Drive. The eastbound turn lane was eliminated from the recently completed W. Oak Street repaving work in anticipation of this future pipe project in order to avoid tearing out new pavement. Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2019.

3. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

Utility work by Duke Energy will commence on February 4 and be on-going over the next few months as various utilities relocate their underground and aerial facilities. One full closure for a few hours is expected to allow Duke Energy to modify their power lines. When the timing of this effort is known, advanced warning will be provided.

4. **NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTOR**

Design work is nearing completion for this project, and offers to purchase right of way have been completed on 12 out of 21 parcels with two parcels having been secured. A definitive construction schedule is not yet known, and all efforts are being made to begin work in the spring of 2019.

5. **NEW MUNICIPAL FACILITY**

Preliminary site design development is complete for the new facility to be located at the former Rail-Trail Gardens along CR 875 E. providing a new home for the Street and Stormwater Department as well as the Parks & Recreation Department. A discussion of finance methods is anticipated sometime in 2019 at the direction of and guidance by the Administration Department.

**6. MAIN ST. BRIDGE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS**

Work is substantially complete on this project. Minor pavement restoration will be necessary in the spring when weather permits.

**7. 2018 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**

Major repaving work will be suspended for the winter. Activities not weather-dependent such as concrete work will continue through the winter.

**8. 2019 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**

Preliminary design work is ongoing for roads currently under consideration for resurfacing and rehabilitation in 2019. The final list of roads will be released upon completion of final estimates.
