### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2019

#### 1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Sixteen (16) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Eight (8) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Multiple plans were reviewed for upcoming Stormwater Management Permits.
- d) Issued one (1) Notice of Violation for Stormwater Permit violations at an active construction site.
- e) The first full round of street sweeping was started on curbed roads in the urban service district collecting and properly disposing of 20.4 tons of debris.

#### 2. **IRONGATE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

This project, designed to help mitigate historical drainage issues along W. Oak Street and Irongate Drive, will be put out for bid in April. A bid opening has been scheduled for April 18<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm.

#### 3. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

Utility relocation work is on-going and construction has begun. The road is closed for the season to through-traffic until November, and local access for residents and businesses is currently available from the north.

#### 4. **NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTOR**

Design work is nearing completion for this project, and offers to purchase right of way have been completed on 12 out of 21 parcels with eleven parcels having been secured, reached agreement, or eliminated. A definitive construction schedule is not yet known, and all efforts are being made to begin work in 2019.

#### 5. **2018 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**

Work continues on road projects contracted last year and suspended for the winter season. Work is on-going in the village area, and paving activities are anticipated to continue in both the village area and Colony Woods subdivision.

**6. 2019 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**

Preliminary design work is completed for roads currently under consideration for resurfacing and rehabilitation in 2019. Repair and resurfacing of the following street segments are being advertised for public bid, with a bid opening scheduled for April 25<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm:

- Ford Rd. from I-865 to Oak St.
- Ford Rd. from Cruse Rd. to Mulberry St.
- Pine St. from 1<sup>st</sup> St. to 6<sup>th</sup> St.
- Andrade Dr.
- Isenhour Hills Dr.
- Tillson Dr.
- Moss Lane
- Summersong Rd.
- Winterstill Rd.
- Waterford Dr. from Village Walk Dr. to Waterford Ct.
- Waterford Ct.

**7. TRAFFIC DATA COLLECTION**

Traffic counts and data collection is on-going town-wide for major intersections and roadways. This data will be used later in 2019 to update the Traffic Impact Fee ordinance.

**8. SPRING BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION**

The spring round of brush and limb collection for Zionsville residents in the urban district has been scheduled for the weeks of April 15<sup>th</sup> and April 22<sup>nd</sup>. In an effort to maximize productivity, there will be a major change to the schedule and process beginning with this spring's collection. In the past, the town was divided into 10 regions, each with a specific scheduled day of collection over a two-week period. Beginning this year, largely due to expanded service areas as a result of the transition of several areas from the rural to the urban service area, the town will be divided into only two (2) larger regions. All residents within each area will be required to place their brush and limbs on the Monday of their week. Town crews will then make as much progress as possible each day, and have all brush and limbs collected by the end of the week. It is the hope that by placing all material curbside on one single day, crews will be able to maximize each day's effort and conclude in a shorter time period as well as easier for residents. The specific schedule and areas have been posted to the Town's web site and coordinated with the Director of Communications and Community Relations for dissemination. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department for their specific week of collection.

**9. ANNUAL HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION**

The annual collection of heavy trash in the urban service district has been set for the week of May 6<sup>th</sup>. This is an opportunity for residents in the urban service district to dispose of non-hazardous household items that are not normally collected with their weekly trash service. Collection will again be on residents' regular trash day during this week, and information and details have been coordinated with the Director of Communications and Community Relations for dissemination. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department directly for information as well. As with previous years, there will be no charge to residents to dispose of tires or refrigerant-bearing appliances; however, residents wishing to dispose of these items are requested to notify the Street and Stormwater Department as the collection process differs from standard heavy-trash items.

## Spring 2019 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street & Stormwater Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning Monday, April 15, 2019**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the Urban Service district a means to dispose of certain pruning and yard debris. All items must be placed curbside by 7:30 a.m. on the Monday of your designated week. Crews will work to collect all properly placed material no later than the following Friday, but may complete this task earlier.

The limit on size is 6 inches in diameter and smaller. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will **NOT** be collected. **Bundling is not required.** Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
