### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2019

#### 1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Eighteen (18) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Eighteen (18) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Multiple plans were reviewed for upcoming Stormwater Management Permits.
- d) The first complete round of sweeping is complete with a total of 61.28 tons of material removed from roadways.

#### 2. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

Utility relocation work and construction is ongoing. The road is closed for the season to through-traffic until November, and local access for residents and businesses is currently available from the north.

#### 3. **NORTH-SOUTH CONNECTOR**

Design work is nearing completion for this project, and offers to purchase right of way have been completed on 19 out of 19 parcels with 11 parcels having been secured. A definitive construction schedule is not yet known, and all efforts are being made to begin work in 2019.

#### 4. **2018 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**

Work is on-going in the village area as well as the Irongate subdivision and is expected to continue through July. Frequent rainfall has hampered progress.

#### 5. **2019 ROAD REHAB PROJECT**

Contract documents have been finalized for the repair and resurfacing of the following street:

- Ford Rd. from I-865 to Oak St.
- Ford Rd. from Cruse Rd. to Mulberry St.
- Pine St. from 1<sup>st</sup> St. to 6<sup>th</sup> St.
- Andrade Dr.
- Isenhour Hills Dr.

- Tillson Dr.
- Moss Lane
- Summersong Rd.
- Winterstill Rd.
- Waterford Dr. from Village Walk Dr. to Waterford Ct.
- Waterford Ct.

Work is expected to begin in July and be completed by November.

**6. TRAFFIC DATA COLLECTION**

Traffic counts and data collection is on-going town-wide for major intersections and roadways. This data will be used later in 2019 to update the Traffic Impact Fee ordinance.

**7. DOWNTOWN FLOWER PLANTERS**

As an initiative of the Mayor, the single, hanging baskets on the downtown street lights have been replaced by double-baskets, and Zionsville flags have been added as well. Additionally, 12 planter pots have been placed throughout the downtown area as well as on the reconstructed bridge over Eagle Creek.
