
Adam District





Summary:

During the month of June, Zionsville Police continued to see increased activity as the State and Town progressed in the re-opening plans from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Calls for service increased again, recording the highest number of any month in 2020. In comparison, calls were up over 200 calls from the same month in 2019.

Zionsville Police bid farewell to Patrol Officer Nicholas Baldwin, a 22 year veteran of the police department. Baldwin will be awarded his retirement service weapon and badge at the July Town Council Meeting. Recruitment has begun for his replacement. Physical and written testing for this process

is slated to begin August 2nd and a projected hire date for our newest officer is November of 2020.

Zionsville Police reported no use of force or major crime statistics in the month of June. Moving forward, the department looks to continue to be proactive in eliminating implicit bias, having contracted with an expert in the area to deliver training to all ZPD personnel.

Committees such as the uniform and shift committees near completion with the goals of providing the department equipment at a discounted rate and enabling officers to bid for shift assignments.
