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### Open House for Indianapolis Executive Airport Land Use Study

The Town of Zionsville and the Hamilton County Airport Authority have announced an open house for updating a Land Use Plan for properties adjoining, in proximity to and in the flight path of the Indianapolis Executive Airport. The open house will take place on Tuesday, July 28 at 7 p.m. at the Indianapolis Executive Airport (11329 East State Road 32, Zionsville, IN 46077).

The purpose of the open house is to gather public input on draft concepts from a team of consultants related to both the growth of the Zionsville community and the growth of the airport in terms of air traffic and runway length.

It is not required to attend the open house in order to participate in the process. Information and initial consultant findings are available on the [Town's website](#).
