Summary:

The month of August was a busy one for Zionsville Police Department. This included the re-integration of the Zionsville Community Schools Police Partner Program along with expanded traffic responsibilities synonymous with the new school year.

Officers participated in the “Project SAVE” grant, targeting violators of school bus stop arm violations. Through their efforts, officers were able to enforce and prevent numerous violations.

Zionsville Police Department members along with community members also conducted interviews for 27 applicants for open patrol positions. Seventeen of those applicants have advanced to the polygraph testing set to take place throughout the month of September. After polygraph examinations, the department will lean heavily on the investigations section for background investigations.

After months of waiting due to the pandemic, the department was finally able to give former Chief Robert Knox, who retired in April, a proper goodbye. On August 3rd, the Town of Zionsville graciously held a retirement ceremony for Chief Knox, who served with ZPD for 36 years, including the last 8+ as the Chief of Police. In attendance were many members of the Town, ZPD, and local/state level political figures.


