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### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2014

#### 1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- Routine inspections of twenty (20) Rule 5-permitted construction sites were conducted last month.
- Continued with the development of documents and procedures and coordinating with the Planning Department, Clerk's Office and Boone County Surveyor for the implementation of stormwater permitting in accordance with the revised Stormwater Ordinance and Technical Standards Manual. Stormwater permit fees went into effect on March 11, 2014.
- Quotes are being obtained for contracted street sweeping services to supplement in-house efforts as provided in the approved 2014 budget.

#### 2. **STORMWATER MANAGEMENT BOARD**

#### 3. **STORMWATER PROJECTS AND DRAINAGE**

Discussions are ongoing with property owners in two (2) locations to acquire easements to allow for the eventual replacement of failing or deficient storm sewers.

Proposals are due on April 4<sup>th</sup> for engineering services to evaluate existing storm sewer infrastructure in the Village area and develop preliminary engineering plans for potential future improvements. The focus area for the project is approximately 1330 linear feet of storm sewer located primarily along Fourth Street from north of West Oak Street to south of Sycamore Street. This area collects runoff from the majority of the residential Village area and represents the furthest downstream, most significant capacity restriction.

#### 4. **FIRST STREET PROJECT**

With the completion of the Sycamore/Main Street intersection study by A&F Engineering, the resulting intersection configuration has been provided to the design engineers for this project, VS Engineering for incorporation. Once completed, the design development plans will be reviewed by the Infrastructure Committee.

5. **ROAD IMPACT FEE UPDATE**

The impact fee study report prepared by A&F Engineering in conjunction with the Council-appointed committee was given a favorable recommendation by the Plan Commission and is now an agenda item for Council consideration and action at its April meeting.

6. **BENNETT PARKWAY EXTENSION PROJECT**

The contractor is currently scheduling the starting of construction activities as the weather improves.

7. **FORD ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS**

This project has been advertised and a bid opening is scheduled for 3:00 pm on April 3<sup>rd</sup>. Five (5) of the six (6) parcels from which additional right-of-way (ROW) is required have been secured or agreed to terms, with the final parcel being offered for Sheriff's sale on April 3<sup>rd</sup>. The outcome of this sale and the Town's success or lack thereof to acquire the property at its appraised value will play a significant role in project timing.

8. **SPRING BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION**

The spring round of brush and limb collection for Zionsville residents in the urban district has been scheduled for the weeks of April 21<sup>st</sup> and April 28<sup>th</sup>. The specific schedule has been posted to the Town's web site and provided to the Times Sentinel and IT department for distribution. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department for their specific day of collection, and the schedule is attached to this report.

9. **ANNUAL HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION**

The annual collection of heavy trash items for Zionsville residents in the urban service district has been set tentatively for the week of May 12<sup>th</sup>. This is an opportunity for residents to dispose of non-hazardous household items that are not normally collected with their weekly trash service. Collection will again be on residents' regular trash day during this week. Information and details will be posted on the Town's web site and will be provided to the Times Sentinel, and people may contact the Street and Stormwater Department directly for this information as well.

## Spring 2014 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street & Stormwater Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning Monday, April 21, 2014**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the Urban district a means to dispose of certain Spring pruning and yard debris. We cannot guarantee the collection unless your items are out curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your designated pick-up day.

Limit on size is 6 inches in diameter. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will NOT be collected. Bundling is not required. Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
