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### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 2016

#### 1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Fourteen (14) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Six (6) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Assisted the Fire Department with the cleanup of an automotive fluid spill resulting from a vehicular accident. Collected absorbent booms deployed by ZFD and used absorbent materials to clean up remaining contaminants and coordinated proper disposal.
- d) Working with WTH Engineering on a pilot project to develop a system for linking available storm sewer televising videos with digital storm sewer mapping features in the town's GIS.
- e) Participating in the coordination of a regional contractor's workshop through the White River Alliance to provide training on construction site stormwater pollution prevention. The training helps the town meet its NPDES stormwater permit requirements and is also intended improve regulatory compliance on local construction sites.

#### 2. **STORMWATER PROJECTS AND DRAINAGE**

- a) Design work has begun on the construction plans for the Fourth Street Storm Sewer Improvement project. Meetings will be scheduled with affected property owners as-appropriate once the project reaches the 60% design stage, scheduled for May, with final design and bidding anticipated in August.
- b) Working with a private utility company to have a damaged storm sewer repaired at their expense on 96<sup>th</sup> Street near the Northwest Technology Center. Based on a televising investigation, the storm sewer appears to have been damaged during utility installation which has resulted in storm pipe failure and localized flooding problems.

3. **96<sup>TH</sup> ST./ZIONSVILLE RD. INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

Design work is complete and right of way acquisition is ongoing on this Boone County Economic Redevelopment Commission funded project which will realign the existing intersection, provide additional lanes through the intersection and modernize the traffic signal equipment. A utility coordination meeting was held on February 17<sup>th</sup>. Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2016, but land acquisition will dictate the project timeline.

4. **BLOOR LANE PATHWAY**

Design work is complete as is right-of-way engineering. Meetings will be scheduled with the property owners to review the final plans and details that might necessitate any changes. Instruments for the conveyance of right of way will be provided to the homeowners and reviewed with them. It is expected that the new right-of-way necessary for the project will be donated to the Town in accordance with the proposal received by the Town Council on or about August 18<sup>th</sup>. Coordination is on-going with Citizens Water regarding two fire hydrants that must be relocated. Construction is expected to begin in the summer of 2016.

5. **FORD RD. ROUNDABOUT LANDSCAPING**

The landscaping to be installed by a local Eagle Scout candidate is scheduled for Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. Support in the way of signs, safety vests and police presence are being provided by the town for this significant volunteer effort.

6. **OAK ST. AND KISSEL INTERSECTION**

The evaluation of this intersection by the Town Engineer is on track to be complete by the end of March. This initiative is seeking a possible interim solution to intersection performance until a roundabout can be funded.

7. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

The Boone County RDC is in the process of refinancing the Browning TIF (commercial area at the northwest corner of 96<sup>th</sup> St. and Zionsville Rd.) bond to generate funds to pay for local road projects in Zionsville. Through discussions between Zionsville and county staff and officials, it has been determined that the Boone RDC will initially fund all phases of an upgrade to Zionsville Rd. The bond placement is scheduled for the May timeframe, after which the BRDC will enter into a design contract with an engineering firm of their selection. Town staff and Mayor Haak will lead the design effort to ensure this project fits the needs of the town. Although no design work has begun, a preliminary meeting with six (6) residents along Zionsville Rd. was held on February 25<sup>th</sup> to discuss general elements. It is currently anticipated that the project will consist of widening the two existing vehicle lanes to 12 feet each and provide a bicycle lane in both directions of 5 feet. There are currently no plans to provide any additional travel lanes. Sidewalks, paths, drainage and other elements will also be considered as the design process unfolds. This project is currently planned to begin at 106<sup>th</sup> St. and continue south, tying into the current intersection reconstruction project at 96<sup>th</sup> St.

8. **HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION**

The annual collection of heavy trash in the urban service district has been set for the week of May 9<sup>th</sup>. This is an opportunity for residents to dispose of non-hazardous household items that are not normally collected with their weekly trash service. Collection will again be on residents' regular trash day during this week.

Information and details will be posted on the Town's web site and provided to the Times Sentinel. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department directly for this information as well. As with previous years, there will be no charge to residents to dispose of tires or refrigerant-bearing appliances. However, residents wishing to dispose of these items are requested to notify the Street Department as the collection process differs from standard heavy-trash items.

**9. BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION**

The spring round of brush and limb collection for Zionsville residents in the urban district has been scheduled for the weeks of April 18<sup>th</sup> and April 25<sup>th</sup>. The specific schedule will be posted to the Town's web site and provided to the Times Sentinel. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department for their specific day of collection, and the schedule is attached to this report.

## Spring 2016 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street & Stormwater Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning Monday, April 18, 2016**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the Urban district a means to dispose of certain spring pruning and yard debris. We cannot guarantee the collection unless your items are out curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your designated pick-up day.

The limit on size is 6 inches in diameter and smaller. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will **NOT** be collected. **Bundling is not required.** Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
