### STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2012

**1. STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

Routine inspections of twelve (12) Rule 5-permitted sites were conducted last month.

Interpretive signage has been developed for the completed rain garden that will educate Town Hall visitors on the purpose and intent of the project, and is scheduled for delivery in September. This also contributes toward the requisite educational initiatives of the Town's NPDES stormwater permit.

The Boone County Solid Waste Management District held its annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day on August 25<sup>th</sup>. Preliminary reports indicate that Zionsville participation nearly doubled since just last year at 499 vehicles visiting the drop-off site.

A Report-a-Polluter feature has been added to the Street and Stormwater page on the Town's web site. The online form allows Zionsville residents to report pollution concerns to Stormwater staff to aid in illicit discharge detection and elimination efforts.

**2. STORMWATER MANAGEMENT BOARD**

No activity as the Board did not meet this month.

**3. FIRST STREET PROJECT**

Final revisions have been made to the design development plans, and meetings with previously identified individual business and property owners facing

significant impacts are complete. However, additional meetings with subsequently identified individual property owners are still ongoing.

**4. 2012 STREET REPAIRS**

Construction of this year's street repairs has begun, and the reconstruction of Saylor St. in the Irongate subdivision is nearly complete. Work will continue throughout September and should be substantially complete by the end of the month. One component of note in this year's project is the replacement of a culvert pipe under south Ford Road in the vicinity of the Farm Fun Preschool. Due to the site conditions, a one-day closure of Ford Rd. will be required, but has not yet been scheduled. Advanced notice will be posted to the Town's web site as well as signage alerting motorists to the expected closure date.

5. **TOWN HALL PATHWAY CONNECTION**

The connector sidewalk from the northern parking lot is substantially complete. Based upon the comments by many trail users, this extension will be well-utilized and appreciated.

6. **SYCAMORE ST. PATHWAY EXTENSION**

As discussed during the 2013 budget process, the extension of the recently completed Sycamore St. pathway over to Elm St. can possibly be constructed using funds already appropriated. Overall the original pathway project was completed significantly under budget, and these funds are being used to extend the pathway from its terminus near the entrance into Lions Park over to the downtown sidewalk system at Elm St. To that end a Notice to Proceed has been issued to the Town Engineer to survey the area; upon completion of the survey, options will be considered as to the use of a boardwalk or retaining wall and railing along the ball diamond and design will commence. It is possible that this project could be completed yet this year, but that depends upon many factors falling perfectly into place.

7. **FALL BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION**

The fall round of brush and limb collection for Zionsville residents in the urban district has been scheduled for the weeks of October 1<sup>st</sup> and October 8<sup>th</sup>. The specific schedule has been posted to the Town's web site and will be advertised in the Times Sentinel. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department for their specific day of collection, and the schedule is attached to this report.

## Fall 2012 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning the week of October 1, 2012**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the urban district a means to dispose of certain Fall pruning and yard debris. We cannot guarantee the collection unless your items are out curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your designated pick-up day.

Limit on size is 6 inches in diameter. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will NOT be collected. Bundling is not required. Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
