Christmas tree disposal sites in Boone County

Zionsville residents have several options for disposing of live trees after the holiday season. During the week of Jan. 2, Ray's Trash Service will pick up Christmas trees curbside for no charge as part of the town's regular trash pickup schedule. Ray's will collect one tree only (at no charge) and the tree must be cut up into sections no longer than four feet tall.

Live Christmas trees can be dropped off at the following Boone County locations. Residents are encouraged to utilize GreenCycle as trees taken to GreenCycle will be turned into mulch.

- **Boone County Resource Recovery**, 985 South US Highway 421, Zionsville. Drop off trees for a \$2 fee during business hours (Monday – Friday from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m. and Saturday from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m.).
- **GreenCycle**, 4227 Perry Worth Road, Whitestown. Drop off trees for recycling for no fee during business hours (Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.). Note: this location is currently closed and will reopen on Jan. 3.

Trees must be bare (no plastic bag, no tinsel, no ornaments, no decorations, no twine).
