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STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2017

1. STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES

- a) Forty (40) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Fourteen (14) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Two (2) Stormwater Management Permits were issued for new development projects.
- d) Held the annual contractor training and certification training program for construction site stormwater pollution prevention requirements. Over 200 people attended the event, 112 of which sat for certification testing.

2. STORMWATER PROJECTS AND DRAINAGE

- a) Working with a fiber optic utility to have repaired at their expense a storm sewer that was damaged during directional drilling work.
- b) Contracting for the emergency repair of a failing trench drain at the intersection of Cedar St. and Main St. The drain failure necessitated the installation of a steel plate as a temporary measure to maintain a drivable road condition.

3. 96TH ST./ZIONSVILLE RD. INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

A Notice to Proceed has been issued to the contractor. Construction activities will commence in April and conclude in August. No closures at the intersection are anticipated, although traffic restrictions and flag control maybe encountered.

4. **OAK ST. AND 800 E. INTERSECTION SIGNAL PROJECT**
The signal is operational and punch-list items and final elements are being addressed to close the contract.
5. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**
Design efforts have begun and will continue over the next several months. A public information meeting will be conducted when design reaches approximately 30%.
6. **FORD RD./OAK ST. INTERSECTION PEDESTRIAN SIGNALS**
Design is complete for the addition of two pedestrian signals at this intersection to complete access in all directions and legs of the intersection. Sidewalks will be added at the northeast corner of the intersection to connect to existing sidewalks in the area. Town staff and representatives are in discussion with the commercial property owner to acquire additional land at the northeast corner.
7. **CR 700 PATHWAY**
The Town expects to close on the purchase of the residential property along the east side of CR 700 in early April. Additional survey has been completed and plans are being finalized in anticipation an advertisement for construction bids within 60 days.
8. **4TH ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE I**
Substantial completion has been achieved with full restoration anticipated in April, pending weather.
9. **4TH ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II**
Design work is ongoing on phase two of the 4th St. Drainage Improvement project, which will upgrade the storm sewers north of Phase I between Hawthorne St. and Pine St. Construction is planned to be completed in 2017.
10. **3RD ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**
Design work is ongoing on a project to increase storm sewer capacity and reduce flooding along portions of N. 3rd St. between Oak St. and Walnut St. Construction is expected to be completed in 2017 and may be constructed in phases pending final cost estimates.
11. **FORD RD. & MULBERRY ST. NEW ROUNDABOUT**
This project is out for bid with a bid opening scheduled for April 13th.
12. **2017 STREET REPAIR AND REHAB PROGRAM**
This project is out for bid with a bid opening scheduled for April 13th. Street segments currently included in the project are:
 - Village Walk Dr., including Village Walk Ct.
 - Oak St./1st St./Sycamore St. corridor generally from Town Hall to Elm St.
 - Templin Rd. (CR 550 S.) from Willow Rd. to Michigan Rd.

- Old 106th St.
- CR 600 S. (Cruse Rd.) from Ford Rd. to CR 950 E.
- 4th St. from Hawthorne St. to Sycamore St.
- 2nd St. from Oak St. to Sycamore St.

Additional roads may be considered yet this year based on pricing received from contractors.

13. COUNTY COOPERATIVE STREET REPAIR AND REHAB PROGRAM

The following roadway segments are currently being repaved using Community Crossings Grant funds matched locally by the Town of Zionsville in the rural service district:

- Hunt Club Road from CR 800 E. to Hull Road
- CR 700 E. from Whitestown town limits to CR 550 S.
- CR 550 S. from CR 700 E. to CR 875 E.

14. HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION

The annual collection of heavy trash in the urban service district has been set for the week of May 8th. This is an opportunity for residents to dispose of non-hazardous household items that are not normally collected with their weekly trash service. Collection will again be on residents' regular trash day during this week, and information and details have been coordinated with the Director of Communications and Community Relations for dissemination. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department directly for this information as well. As with previous years, there will be no charge to residents to dispose of tires or refrigerant-bearing appliances. However, residents wishing to dispose of these items are requested to notify the Street Department as the collection process differs from standard heavy-trash items.

15. BRUSH AND LIMB COLLECTION

The spring round of brush and limb collection for Zionsville residents in the urban district has been scheduled for the weeks of April 17th and April 24th. The specific schedule has been posted to the Town's web site and coordinated with the Director of Communications and Community Relations for dissemination. Residents may contact the Street and Stormwater Department for their specific day of collection, and the schedule is attached to this report.

Spring 2017 Brush & Limb Collection

The Town of Zionsville's Street & Stormwater Department will be providing curbside Brush & Limb Collection **beginning Monday, April 17, 2017**. This service provides Zionsville residents in the Urban district a means to dispose of certain spring pruning and yard debris. We cannot guarantee the collection unless your items are out curbside by 7:30 a.m. on your designated pick-up day.

The limit on size is 6 inches in diameter and smaller. Grass clippings, leaves, decorative grass, vines, stumps, root balls, construction lumber, firewood, and wooden fencing material will NOT be collected. Bundling is not required. Limbs up to 6 inches in diameter may be left intact but should be no larger than can be managed by one person.
