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STREET AND STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2017

1. **STORMWATER PERMIT ACTIVITIES**

- a) Seventeen (17) stormwater pollution prevention plan inspections were conducted at permitted construction sites.
- b) Eight (8) Stormwater Individual Lot Permits were issued for new residential construction projects.
- c) Participated in the Zion Nature Center's Creekstomp event.
- d) Participated in the regional Boy Scout summer camp at Camp Belzer by staffing a White River Alliance educational booth. Hundreds of area scouts and their families attend the camp.
- e) Conducted semi-annual stormwater facility assessments at Fire Stations 91 and 92, the Golf Course and Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- f) Implemented corrective action in response to the three minor deficiencies noted in reports provided by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management from their audit conducted on February 24th, 2017. The Town received an overall satisfactory audit rating for both Stormwater Quality Management Program implementation and facility compliance.
- g) Coordinating the annual Creekfest event and stream cleanup which will be held at Elm Street Green on Saturday, August 19th.

2. **STORMWATER PROJECTS AND DRAINAGE**

- a) Worked with a fiber optic utility to have repaired, at their expense, a storm sewer that was damaged during directional drilling work.

3. **96TH ST./ZIONSVILLE RD. INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

Construction will continue through the summer. No full closures at the intersection are currently anticipated, although traffic restrictions and flag control may be encountered at any time.

4. **ZIONSVILLE RD. PROJECT**

Design efforts will continue over the next several months. A public information meeting has been scheduled for July 19th at 6:30 pm in the Community Room of the Town Hall to present the current design and configuration to anyone interested.

5. **FORD RD./OAK ST. INTERSECTION PEDESTRIAN SIGNALS**

Design is complete for the addition of two pedestrian signals at this intersection to complete access in all directions and legs of the intersection. Sidewalks will be added at the northeast corner of the intersection to connect to existing sidewalks in the area. Town staff and representatives are in discussion with the commercial property owner to acquire additional land at the northeast corner.

6. **CR 700 PATHWAY**

The Town has obtained all necessary right of way and/or property along the east side of CR 700. Plans are being finalized by the Town engineer in anticipation of an advertisement for construction bids.

7. **4TH ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II**

Design work is ongoing on phase two of the 4th St. Drainage Improvement project, which will upgrade the storm sewers north of Phase I between Hawthorne St. and Pine St. Construction is planned to be completed in 2017.

8. **3RD ST. DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Design work is ongoing on a project to increase storm sewer capacity and reduce flooding along portions of N. 3rd St. between Oak St. and Walnut St. Construction is expected to be completed in 2017 and may be constructed in phases pending final cost estimates.

9. **FORD RD. & MULBERRY ST. NEW ROUNDABOUT**

Construction is ongoing.

10. **2017 STREET REPAIR AND REHAB PROGRAM**

Work is ongoing in various locations for the next two months. Areas include:

- Oak St./1st St./Sycamore St. corridor generally from Town Hall to Elm St.
- Templin Rd. (CR 550 S.) from Willow Rd. to Michigan Rd.
- Old 106th St.
- CR 600 S. (Cruse Rd.) from Ford Rd. to CR 950 E.
- 4th St. from Hawthorne St. to Sycamore St.
- 2nd St. from Oak St. to Sycamore St.

11. **VILLAGE WALK DR. RECONSTRUCTION**

Work is ongoing.
