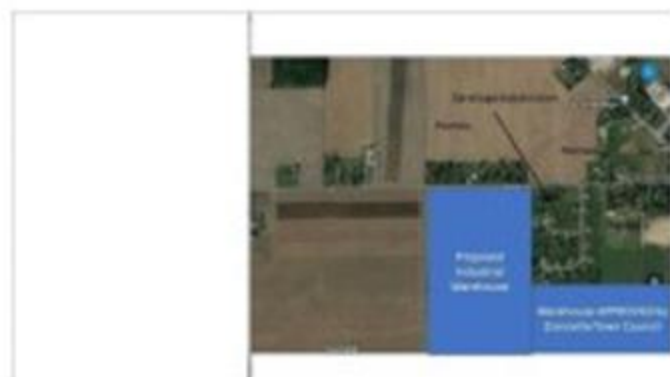


Can you please include this into my public statement next week.
