

**ORDINANCE NO. 2023- 03
OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE, INDIANA**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE,
CHAPTER 75: PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING SCHEDULES,
SCHEDULE III OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ZIONSVILLE, IN
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE § 9-21-1-3**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 9-21-1-3 confers upon the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana (“Town Council”) the power to identify stop intersections, establish speed limits, and adopt any other traffic regulations specifically authorized by Indiana Code § 9-21 with respect to streets and highways under the Town of Zionsville’s (“Town”) jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council now desires to amend Schedule III of the Traffic Code, Title VII, Chapter 75.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Boone County, Indiana, meeting in regular session as follows:

Section 1. Amendment to Schedule III. Loading Zones. The Town Council hereby amends Title VII: Traffic Code, Chapter 75: Parking, Stopping and Standing Schedules, Schedule III: Parking Time Limits as follows by adding a new table (D) and inserting the following language:

(D) Parking prohibited between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on days when school is in session.

<i>Street</i>	<i>Side(s)</i>	<i>Location</i>
Governors Lane	Both	From its intersection with CR 975 E. to its intersection with Sherwood Ct.
Rockwell Ct.	Both	The entirety of the street from its intersection with Governors Lane to its dead end.

Section 2. Remaining Provisions. The remaining provisions of the Zionsville Code of Ordinances, Title VII: Traffic Code, Chapter 75: Parking, Stopping and Standing Schedules, Schedule III: Parking Time Limits, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and are not affected by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Repeal of Prior Ordinances. All prior Town ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

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Section 4. Construction of Clause Headings. The clause headings appearing herein have been provided for convenience and reference and do not purport and shall not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clause to which they appertain.

Section 5. Severability. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 6. Duration and Effective Date. The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect following the date of its passage and action by the Mayor and/or the Town Council in the manner prescribed by Reorganization section ZR2A18 and shall remain in full force and effect until amended or repealed by ordinance of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana as follows:
