ORDINANCE 2021-02_ OF THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE

AN ORDINANCE REESTABLISHING THE SAFETY BOARD FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT MATTERS

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 36-8-3 *et seq*. confers upon the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana (the "Town Council") the authority to establish a Safety Board ("Board"); and

WHEREAS, for many years the Town Council has appointed three (3) members of the Town Council to serve as the Safety Board for the Town for Fire Department matters; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Town Council adopted Resolution 2014-11, commonly referred to as Reorganization 2.0, to further reorganize the Town of Zionsville ("Town"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to reestablish the Board as part of an on-going process to update the Code of Ordinances and ensure compliance with Resolution 2014-11 and state law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code 36-8-3 *et seq*. the Board will be considered the Safety Board of the Town for fire department purposes..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY, by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Boone County, that:

- 1. <u>Establishment of Safety Board</u>. The Council hereby establishes the Board, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-8-3 *et seq.*, with the powers and duties provided under state law.
 - a. Number of Members. The Board shall consist of five (5) members.
 - b. <u>Term</u>. The term of each Board member shall be one (1) year, expiring on December 31st of the member's appointment.
 - c. <u>Appointment to the Board</u>. The Town Council shall appoint all five (5) members to the Board.
 - d. <u>Composition of Board</u>. The Board shall be comprised of not more than three (3) members of the Town Council. Any Town Council member that serves on the Board shall vacate the member's position on the Board when the member is no longer a member of the Town Council. The Board shall also include two (2) citizen members.

2. Powers and Duties of Board.

The Board shall consistute the Safety Board of the Town for purposes of the suspension, demotion, or dismissal of any member of the Fire Department. Proceedings for the suspension, demotion, or dismissal of any member of the Fire Department as provided for herein shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by Ind. Code § 36-8-3-4. The disciplinary provisions of Ind. Code § 36-8-3-4.1 shall apply to the Safety Board.

- 3. <u>Construction of Clause Headings</u>. The clause headings appearing herein have been provided for convenience and reference and do not purport and shall not be deemed to define, limit or extend the scope or intent of the clause to which they appertain.
- 4. <u>Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances</u>. The provisions of all other Town ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof, if any, are of no further force or effect and are hereby repealed.
- 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
- 6. <u>Duration and Effective Date</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately and remain in full force and effect until repeal by ordinance.

Introduced and filed on the <u>rest</u> day of February, 2021. A motion to consider on First Reading was sustained by a vote of <u>7</u> in favor and <u>0</u> opposed, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-5-2-9.8.
