WHEREAS, drowning is the leading cause of accidental death in children ages 5 and under; and,

WHEREAS, water safety and learning to swim are essential life skills; and,

WHEREAS, the Zionsville Aquatic Center, Azionaqua Swim Club and Zionsville Swim Club stand together in the mission to educate Zionsville residents about the importance of water safety; and,

WHEREAS, the Zionsville Aquatic Center together with Azionaqua Swim Club and Zionsville Swim Club will offer a water safety class on Tuesday, June 15, 2021 from 6:30 – 7 p.m. for all residents teaching caregivers and children how to take steps to ensure water safety; and,
