

ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 13
OF THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE, INDIANA

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
TRAFFIC CODE OF THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE
CODE OF ORDINANCES
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE §9-21-1-3**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §9-21-1-3 confers upon the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana (“Town Council”) the power to identify stop intersections, establish speed limits, and adopt any other traffic regulations specifically authorized by Indiana Code § 9-21 with respect to streets and highways under the Town of Zionsville’s (“Town”) jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Trailside Elementary is a new public school located near and along CR 875 E. within a larger school campus served by two access drives accessing said road; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council now desires to amend Schedule VI of the Traffic Code, Title VII, Chapter 74.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Boone County, Indiana, meeting in regular session as follows:

Section 1. Schedule VI. School Zones. The Town Council hereby amends Schedule VI by inserting the following underscored language:

<i>Name of Street/Portions Affected</i>	<i>Maximum Speed Limit</i>	<i>When Limit Applies</i>
<u>C.R. 875 EAST from a point 330 feet south of its intersection with of SPRING VIOLET PLACE to a point 1,890 feet north of that same intersection</u>	<u>30 MPH</u>	<u>WHEN FLASHER IS FLASHING</u>

Section 2. Construction of Clause Headings. The clause headings appearing herein have been provided for convenience and reference and do not purport and shall not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clause to which they appertain.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. The provisions of all other Town ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof, if any, are of no further force or effect and are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

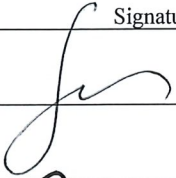
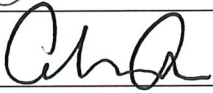
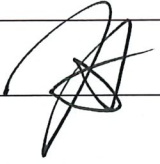
Section 5. Duration and Effective Date. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective when signs giving notice of the maximum speed limit are posted upon the part of the street that is affected and remain in full force and effect until repealed by ordinance.

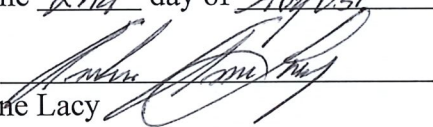
