## **ORDINANCE 2022-17\_\_**

## AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A ZIONSVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT GRANT FUND (FUND \_456\_\_\_\_) FOR THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town of Zionsville ("Town") desires to establish a Zionsville Volunteer Fire Department ("ZVFD") Grant Fund into which the liquidated assets of the ZVFD are transferred pursuant to a Grant Agreement executed by the Town, the Zionsville Town Council ("Town Council") and the ZVFD on October 18, 2021 (the "Grant Agreement"); and
WHEREAS, the Town desires to ensure that the liquidated assets of the ZVFD are transferred to the Zionsville Volunteer Fire Department Grant Fund _456 and are expended subject to Town Council appropriation and used exclusively for the benefit of the Zionsville Fire Department, for capital projects and not as a subsidy or replacement of ordinary and normal operating expenses of the Zionsville Fire Department, in accordance with the Grant Agreement.
<b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED</b> by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana as follows:
Section 1: <b>Fund Established.</b> The Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana, does hereby create Fund No456 which is designated as the Zionsville Volunteer Fire Department Grant Fund and shall be the depository fund for assets received from the ZVFD pursuant to the Grant Agreement.
Section 2: <b>Permitted Uses.</b> All liquidated assets transferred into the Zionsville Volunteer Fire Department Grant Fund shall be expended subject to Town Council appropriation and used exclusively for the benefit of the Zionsville Fire Department, for capital projects and not as a subsidy or replacement of ordinary and normal operating expenses of the Zionsville Fire Department, in accordance with the Grant Agreement.
Section 3: <b>Internal Controls.</b> Internal controls shall be designated, implemented, and documented to provide reasonable assurance that the Zionsville Volunteer Fire Department Grant Funds will be safeguarded and used in accordance with this Ordinance.
Introduced and filed on the 3rd day of October, 2022. A motion to consider on First Reading was sustained by a vote of in favor and opposed, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-5-2-9.8.
