WHEREAS, Dr. Robison has been the superintendent of Zionsville Community Schools (ZCS) since 2006 – nearly two decades – and his last day in the office is January 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Robison has worked in public education for nearly four decades, including previously leading schools in Sheridan, Westfield, Indianapolis and Ft. Wayne; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, Dr. Robison was named the Indiana School Boards Associations (ISBA) Educator of the Year; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Robison has served in many organizations in the community including on chambers of commerce, a municipal redevelopment commission, a parks advisory board, a non-profit board of directions, a community revitalization committee, common wage boards and more; and

WHEREAS, under Dr. Robison's leadership, ZCS continues to rank among the top five highest-performing districts in the state and over the past 16 years, ZCS has had the second-largest student enrollment increase of any district in the state; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Zionsville urges all citizens to participate to celebrate Dr. Scott Robison Day and recognize Dr. Robison for his commitment to academic excellence, strong financial stewardship and attention to personal relationships.
