

ORDINANCE NO. 2023- 02 _____
OF THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE, INDIANA

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE, CHAPTER 75: PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING
SCHEDULES, SCHEDULE I. LOADING ZONES OF
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ZIONSVILLE, IN
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE § 9-21-1-3**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §9-21-1-3 confers upon the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana (“Town Council”) the power to identify stop intersections, establish speed limits, and adopt any other traffic regulations with respect to streets and highways under the Town of Zionsville’s (“Town”) jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council now desires to amend the Title VII, Traffic Code, Chapter 75, Schedule I. Loading Zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Boone County, Indiana, meeting in regular session as follows:

Section 1. Schedule I. Loading Zones. The Town Council hereby amends the Code of Ordinances for Zionsville, IN, Title VII, Traffic Code, Chapter 75, Schedule I. Loading Zones by deleting the following stricken language:

<i>Street</i>	<i>Side</i>	<i>Location</i>	<i>Special Provisions</i>
First Street	East	From its intersection with Oak Street north to its intersection with Cedar Street	Reserved and limited as a loading zone only from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday through Friday.

Section 2. Remaining Provisions. The remaining provisions of the Zionsville Code of Ordinances, Title VII: Traffic Code, Chapter 75: Parking, Stopping and Standing Schedules, Schedule III: Parking Time Limits, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and are not affected by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Repeal of Prior Ordinances. All prior Town ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Construction of Clause Headings. The clause headings appearing herein have been provided for convenience and reference and do not purport and shall not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clause to which they appertain.

Section 5. Severability. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 6. Duration and Effective Date. The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect following the date of its passage and action by the Mayor and/or the Town Council in the manner

prescribed by Reorganization section ZR2A18 and shall remain in full force and effect until amended or repealed by ordinance of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana as follows:

Introduced and filed on the 6th day of February, 2023. A motion to consider on First Reading was properly made and seconded and approved by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-5-2-9.4 and § 36-5-2-9.6.

A motion to consider on Second reading was properly made and seconded and approved by a vote of 7 in favor and 0 opposed, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-5-2-9.4, § 36-5-2-9.6 or § 36-5-2-9.8 (*as applicable*).

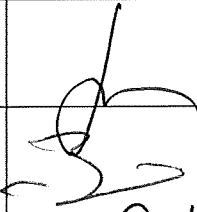
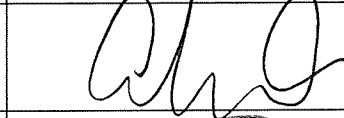
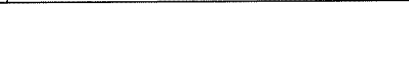
