

ORDINANCE 2023-__06__

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING NEW FUNDS (FUND NO. __255__ AND FUND NO. __256__)
FOR THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 4-6-15 addresses Opioid Litigation and Settlements; and

WHEREAS, Indiana is part of a \$26 billion dollars national settlement with Johnson & Johnson, AmerisourceBergen, Cardinal Health and McKesson, to which Indiana's share of the settlement is approximately \$507 million dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Zionsville expects to receive approximately \$87,000.00 of the statewide settlement distributed over a period of several years and must now have two (2) new funds established for receipt and distribution of funds; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance requests that two (2) new accounts, Fund No. 255__ and Fund No. __256__ be dedicated and created for the receipt and disbursement of restricted and unrestricted funds received from such settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana, that the Director of Finance be and is authorized to provide, dedicate, and create two (2) new accounts for the Town of Zionsville as follows:

Section 1: Fund No. __256__ Opioid Settlement Unrestricted.
Fund No. __255__ Opioid Settlement Restricted.

Section 2: Expenditures from Fund No. __255__ and Fund No. __256__ shall be made by appropriation by the Town Council.

Section 3: The Funds shall be perpetual until terminated by Ordinance of the Town Council.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council and approval by the Mayor.

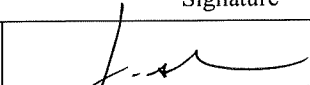
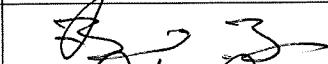
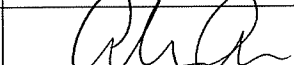
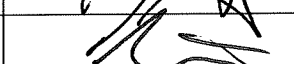
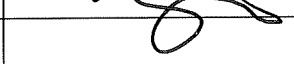
