

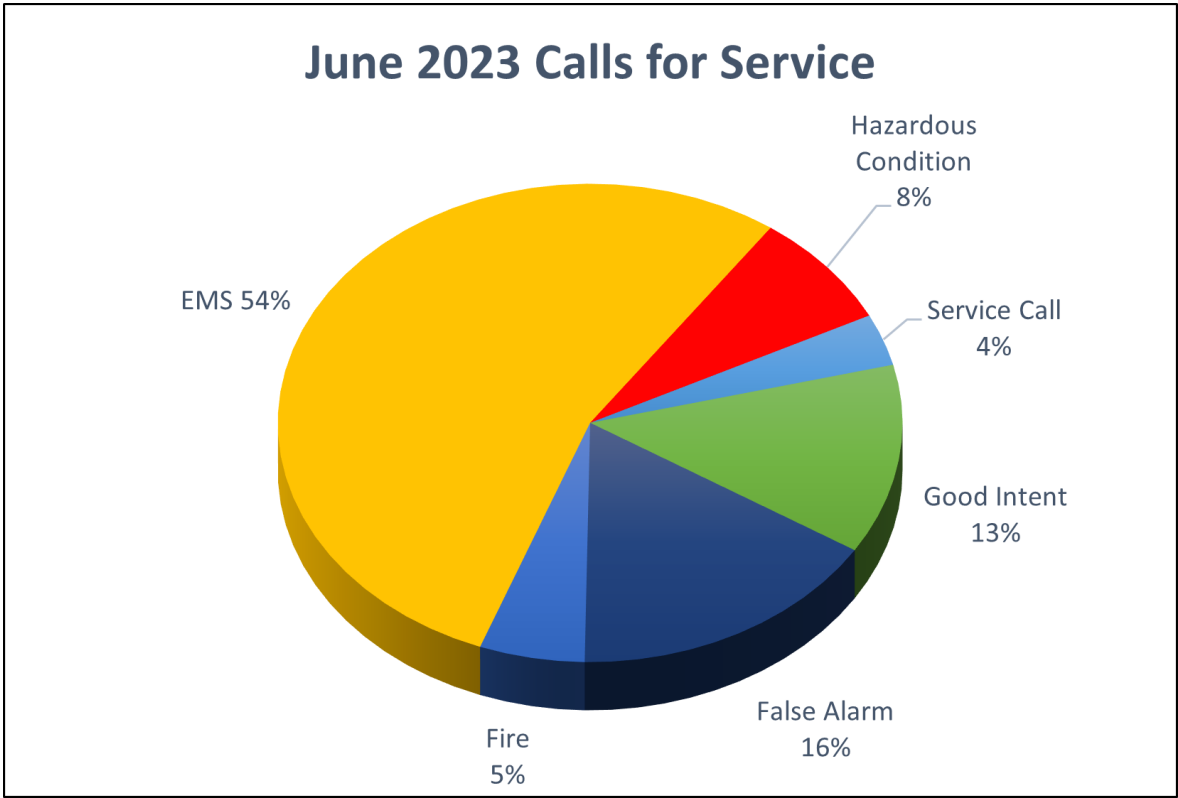

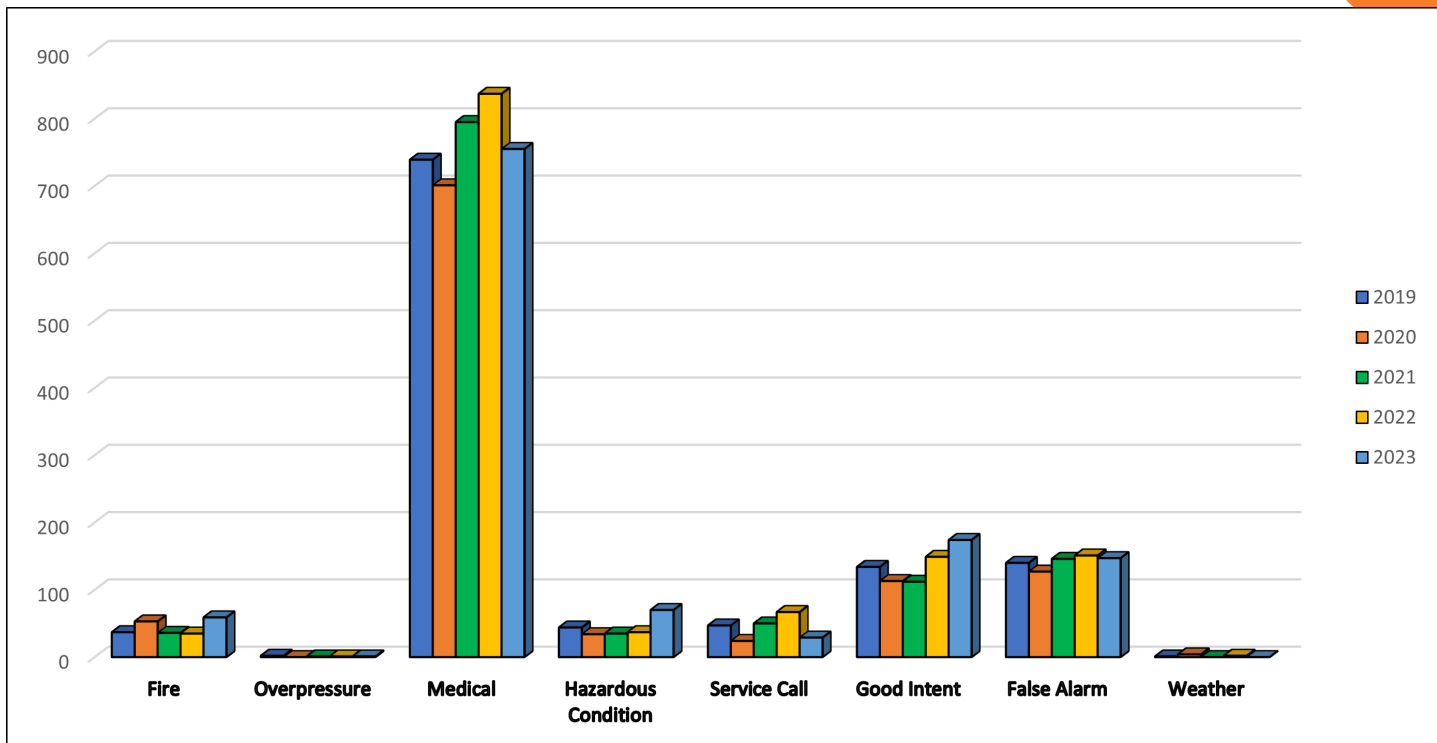

- Attended meeting with LFD about SAFER grants

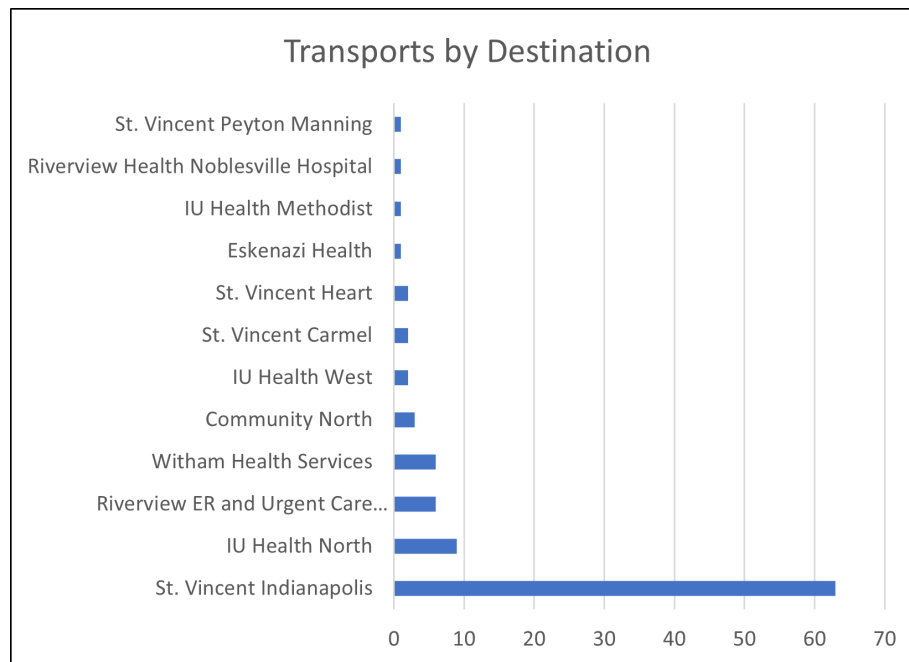

- Conducted weekly operations meetings with Battalion Chiefs



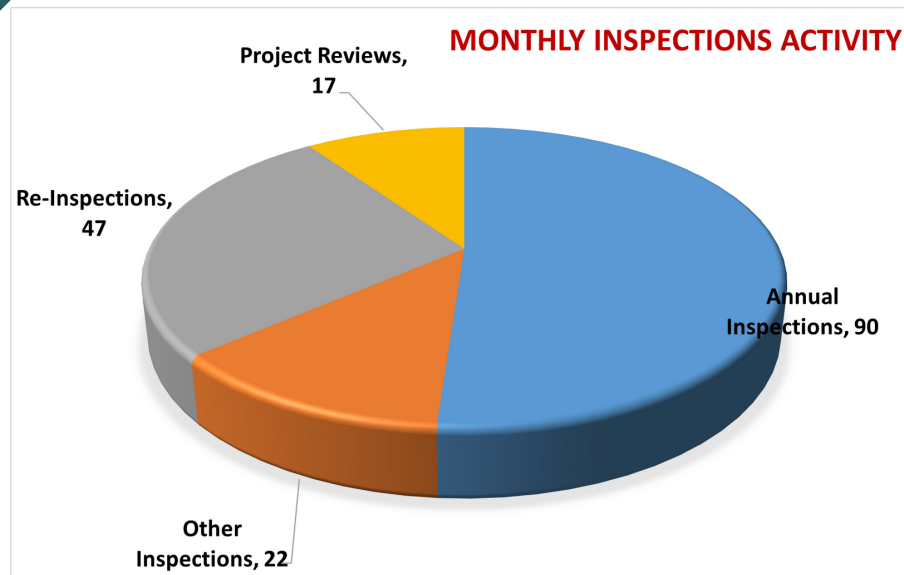

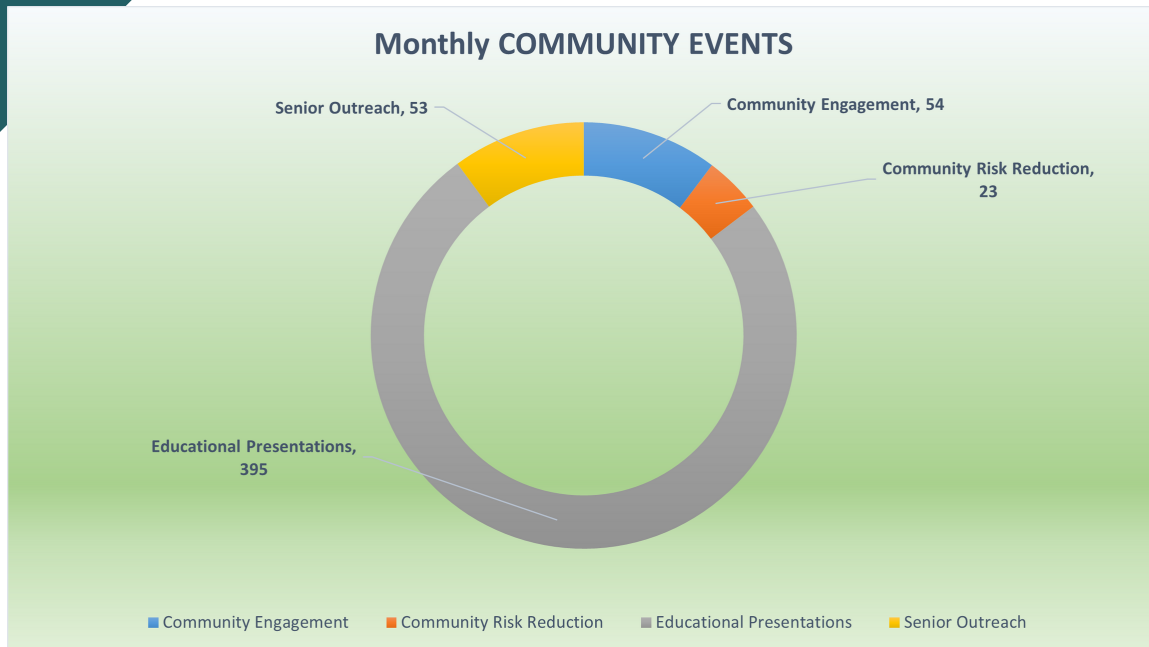
