## ORDINANCE NO. 2024-16 OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ZIONSVILLE, INDIANA

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE, CHAPTER 74: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES, SCHEDULE II OF THE ZIONSVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE§ 9-21-1-3

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 9-21-1-3 confers upon the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Indiana ("Town Council") the power to identify stop intersections, establish speed limits, and adopt any other traffic regulations specifically authorized by Ind. Code § 9-21 *et seq.* with respect to streets and highways under the Town of Zionsville's ("Town") jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's administration has recommended to the Town Council to amend the Code to modify the stop intersection at Redd Road and Bennett Parkway; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Council now desires to amend Schedule II, Through Streets and Stop Intersections, of the Traffic Code, Title VII, Chapter 74 to make such change.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Town Council of the Town of Zionsville, Boone County, Indiana, meeting in regular session as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. <u>Amendment to Schedule II.</u> Through Streets and Stop Intersections. The Town Council hereby amends Title VII: Traffic Code, Chapter 74: Traffic Schedules, Schedule II, Through Streets and Stop Intersections, by inserting the following language:

Street/Special Provision	Intersection	Type of Stop
Redd Road	Bennett Parkway	

Section 3. <u>Remaining Provisions.</u> The remaining provisions of the Zionsville Code of Ordinances, Title VII: Traffic Code, Chapter 74: Traffic Schedules, Schedule II: Through Streets and Stop Intersections, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and are not affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. <u>Repeal of Prior Ordinances</u>. All prior Town ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 5. <u>Construction of Clause Headings</u>. The clause headings appearing herein have been provided for convenience and reference and do not purport and shall not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clause to which they appertain.

Section 6. <u>Severability</u>. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 7. <u>Duration and Effective Date.</u> The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect following the date of its passage and action by the Town Council and the Mayor in the manner prescribed by Reorganization section ZR2A18 and shall remain in full force and effect until amended or repealed by ordinance of the Town Council.
