

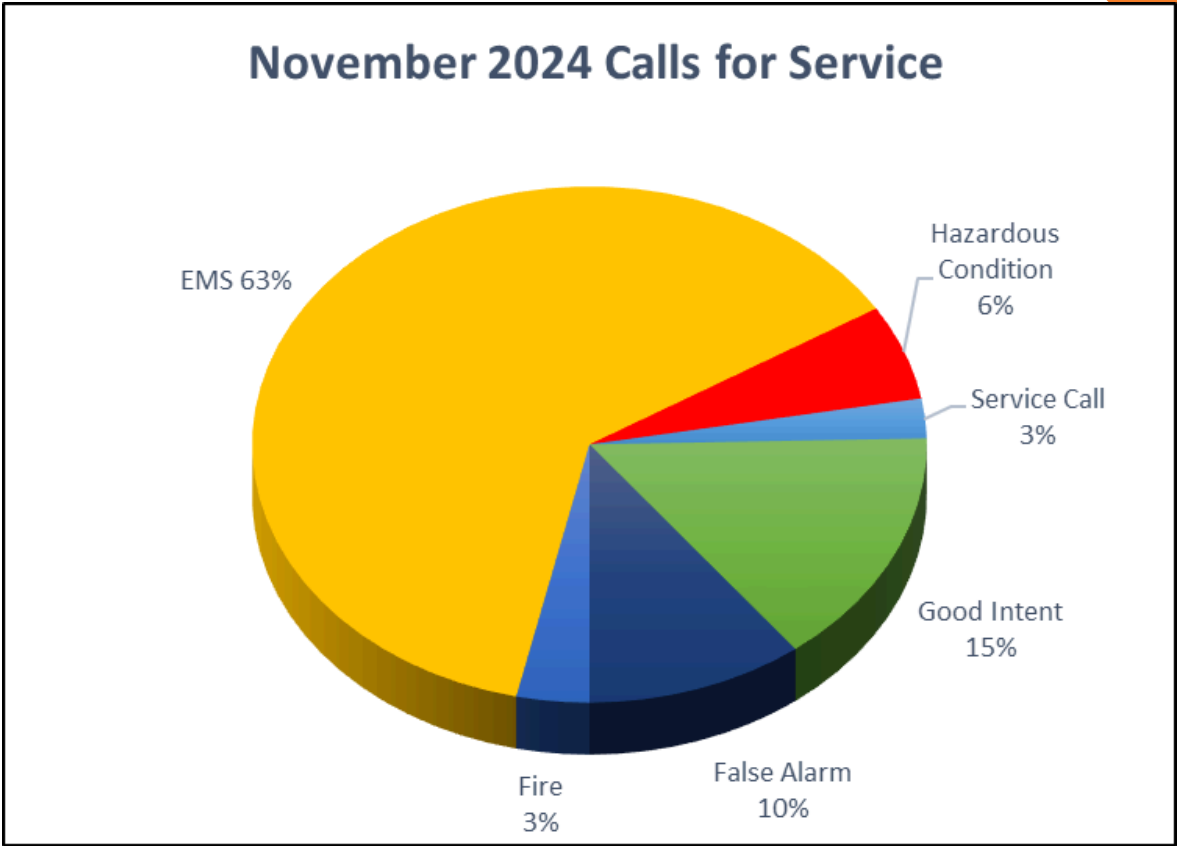

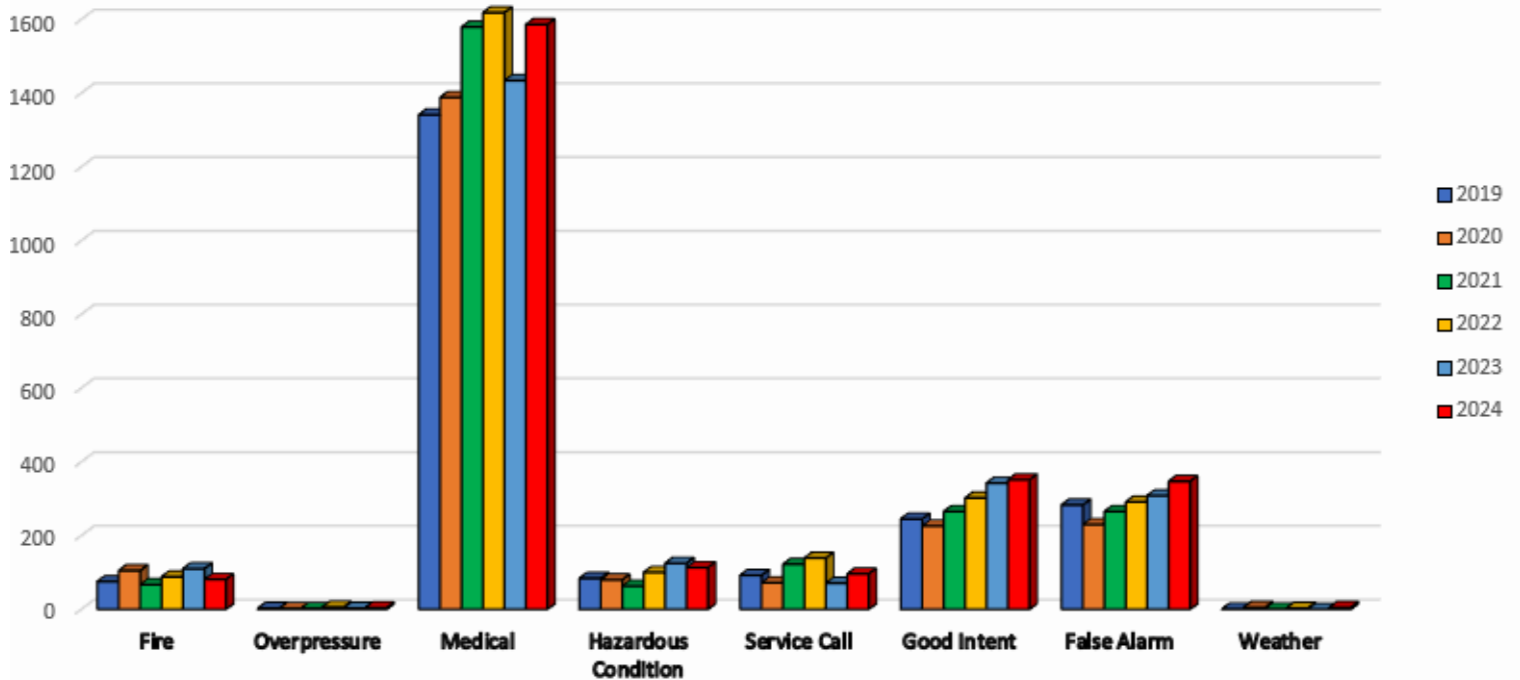

- Checked in on our firefighters who are off duty

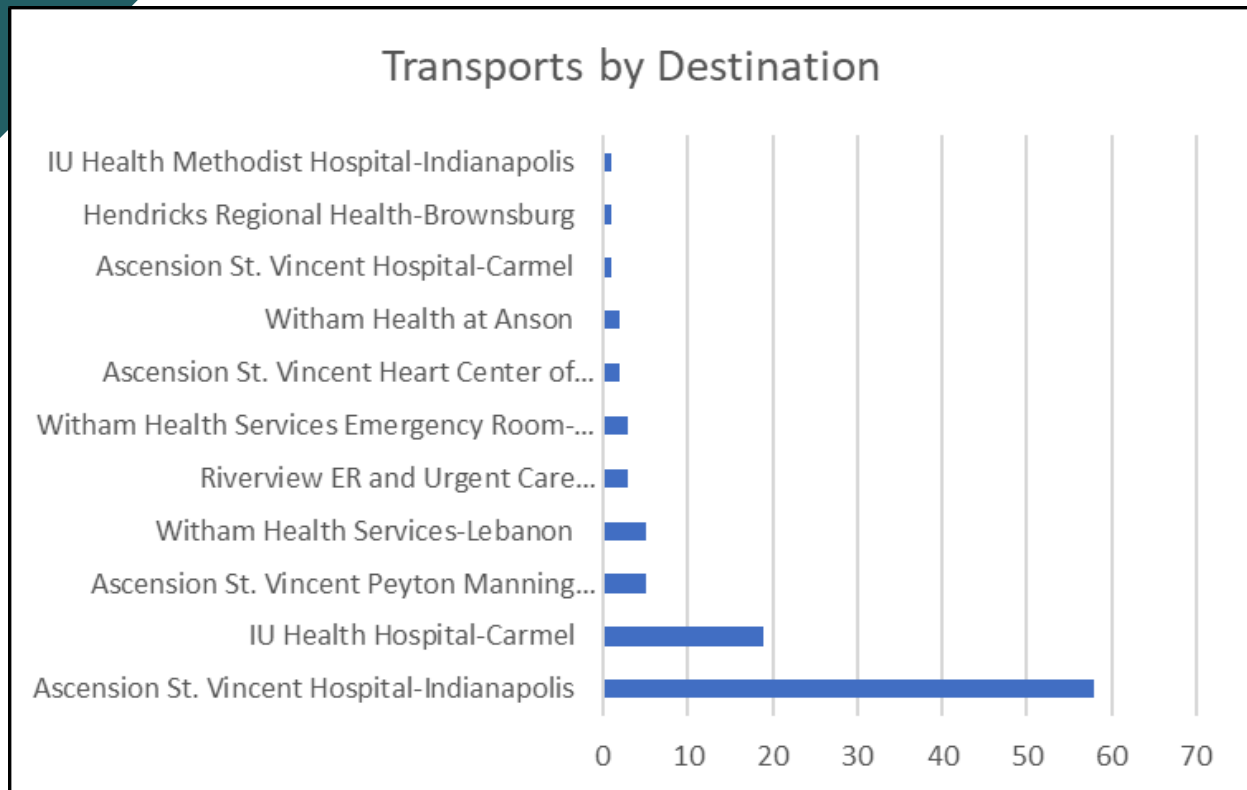

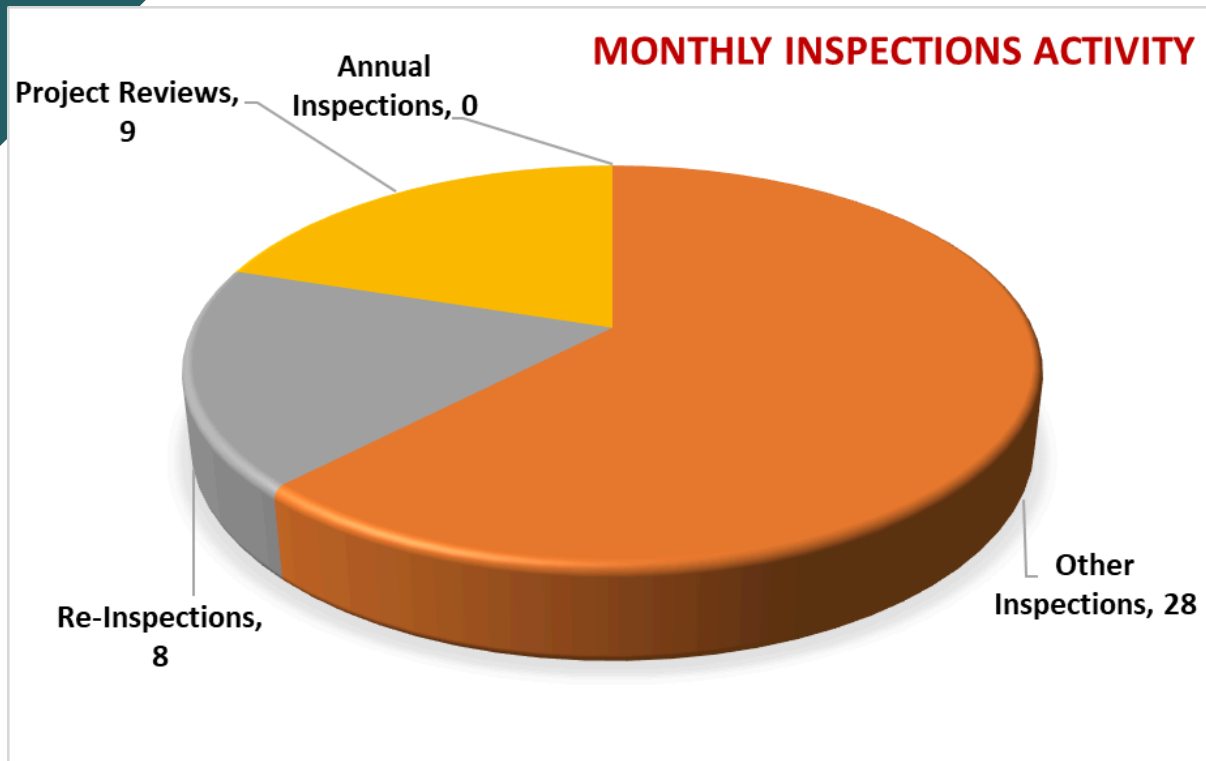

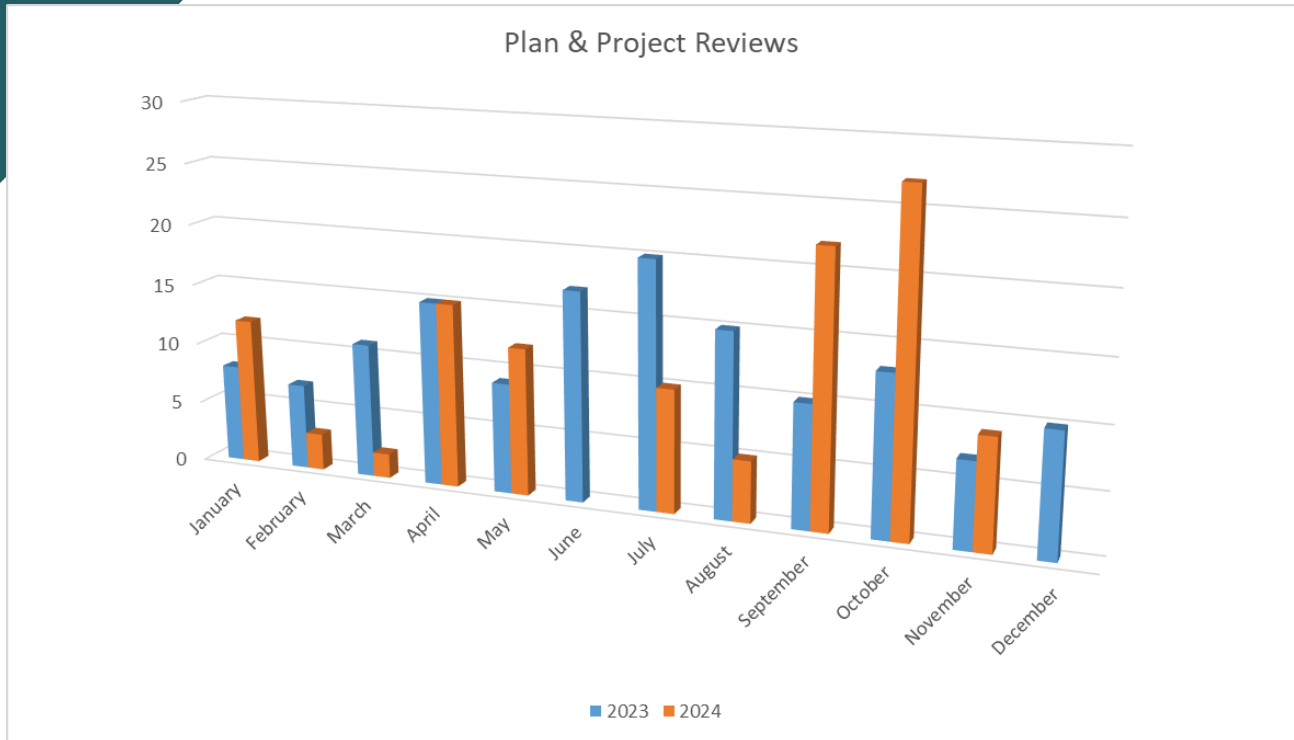
