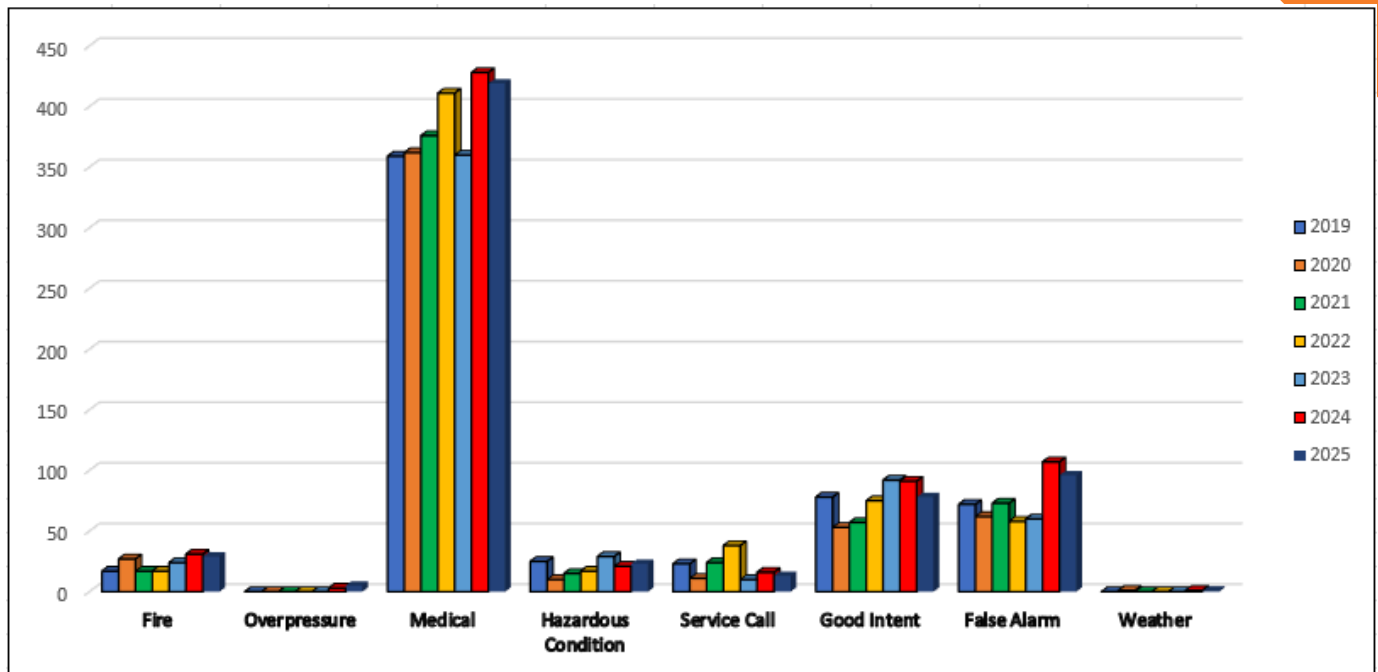

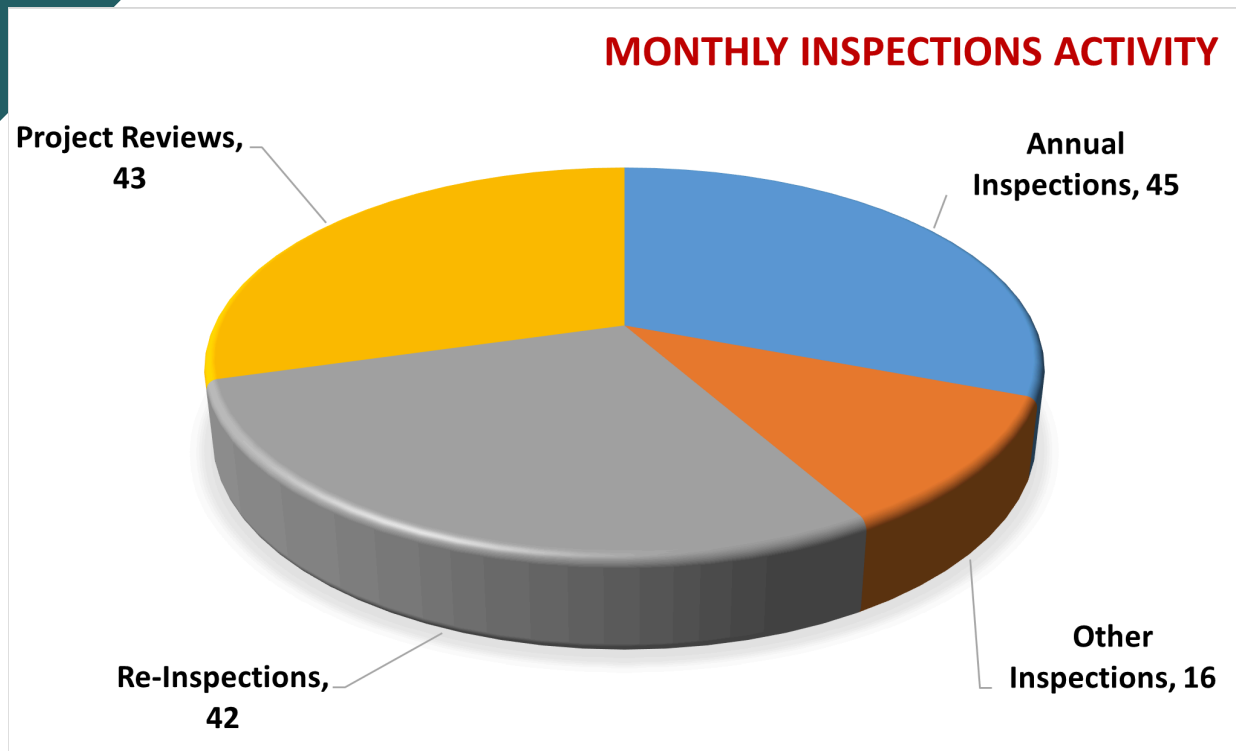
- Competition Team and STC Vardaman completed the Handtevy training

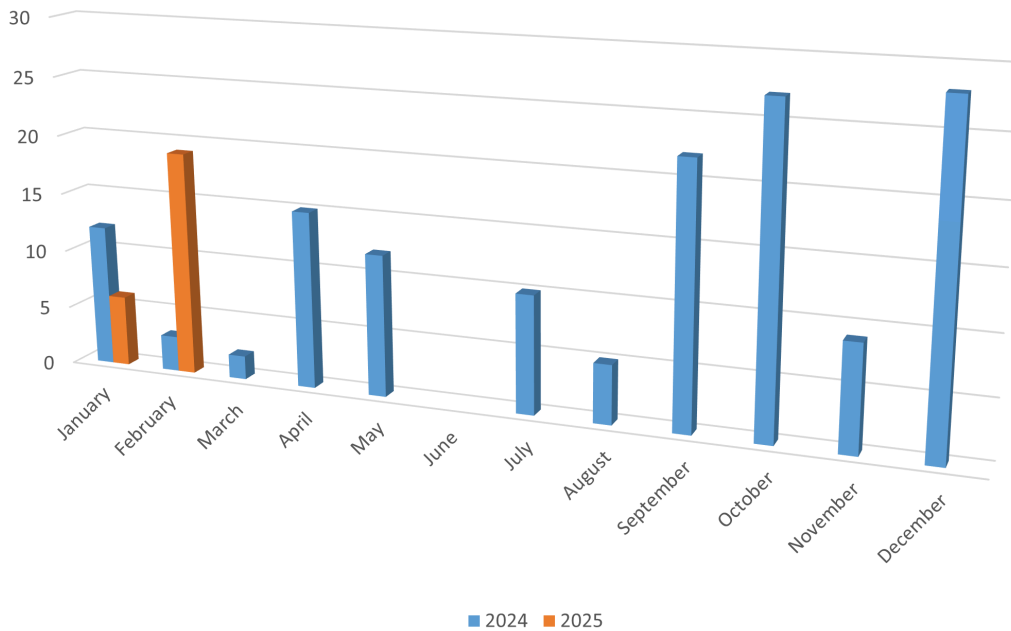
