**WHEREAS**, Jean Apple has served on the Town of Zionsville's People of Zionsville for the Aesthetics of Zionsville (PZAZ) committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Apple co-founded the Village Resident Association (VRA) and was the association's first president; and

**WHEREAS**, Apple helped establish the Lamplighter Award in 2003 and the VRA has since presented the award to homeowners in the Village who preserve older homes; and

WHEREAS, Apple, passionate about preservation and volunteer work, has served as president of the Zionsville Historical Society, a board member of Maplelawn Farmstead and president of the Kiwanis; and

WHEREAS, Apple was instrumental in establishing a plaque at the pocket park at the corner of Main and Cedar Streets to coincide with the Town's sesquicentennial celebration; and

**WHEREAS**, in the early 1960s, Apple was part of the group that started the Off Main Street Players theatre troupe, performing in the Hurst dairy barn in a farm on property that is now part of Raintree.

**NOW THEREFORE**, recognizing Jean Apple's dedication to the Town of Zionsville and the community through her service as a PZAZ member, co-founder of the VRA, president of the Zionsville Historical Society, board member of Maplelawn Farmstead and more,
