**Artwork submissions accepted April 1 – 15, 2022 during regular business hours at Zionsville Town Hall and the Hussey Mayfield Memorial Public Library.**

- Artwork must use a minimum of 50% recycled materials.
- Artwork may be two-dimensional or three-dimensional but shall not exceed 16" in any direction.
- Artwork will be on display on Saturday, April 23, 2022, from 9:00 am – noon at town hall.
- Artists may collect their artwork at town hall on Saturday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> between noon and 3:00 pm. Please email [wschrepferman@zionsville-in.gov](mailto:wschrepferman@zionsville-in.gov) if you require different arrangements.
- Submissions shall not include political, religious, or offensive content.
- Art will be judged in three age categories: 5 - 8 years, 9 - 13 years, and 14 - 18 years.
- Awards will be announced via social media at the conclusion of the event. Artists are not required to be present to win and will be contacted via email to arrange prize collection.
